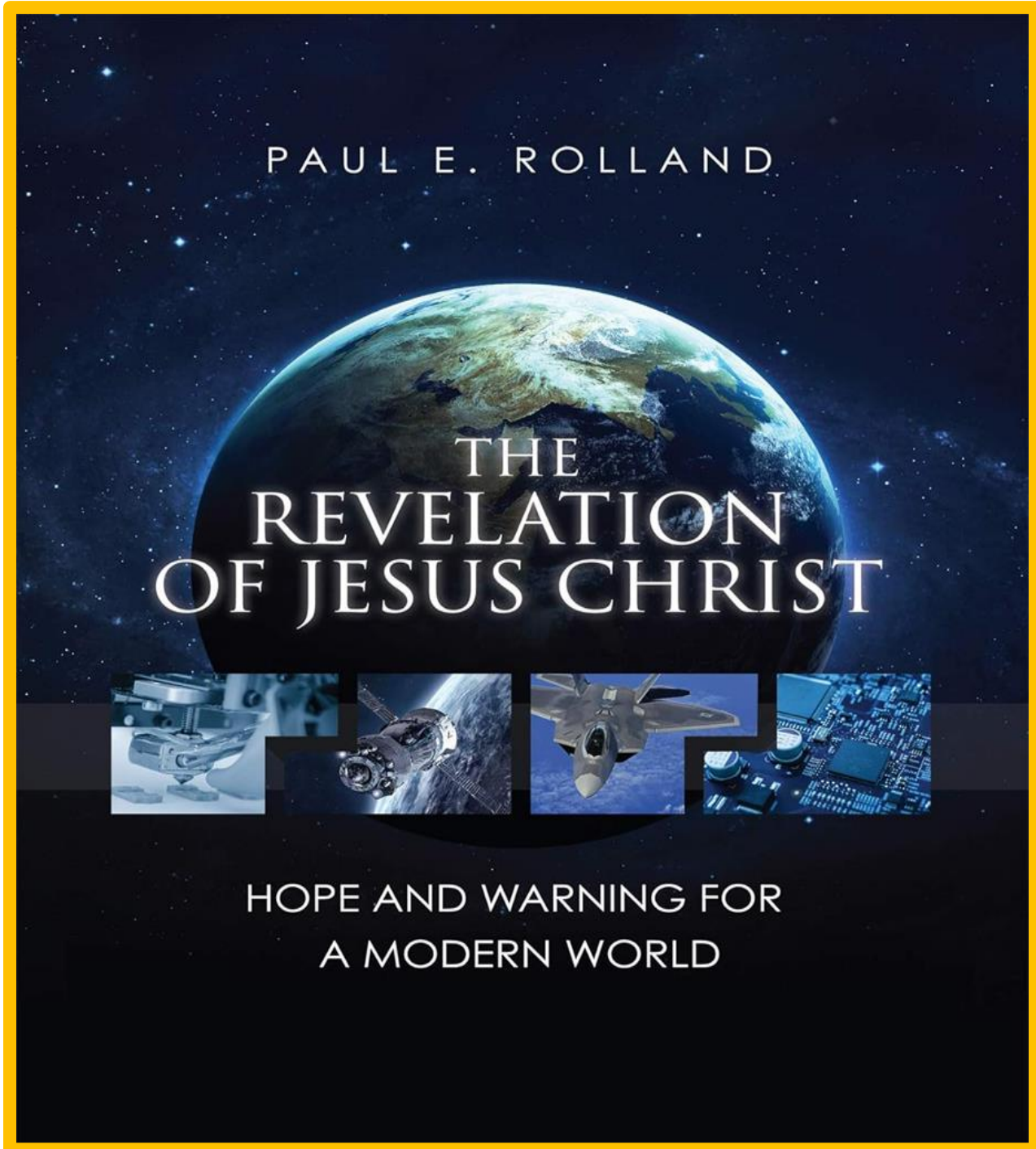

## **NEW UN NEEDED TO AVERT BREAKDOWN OF LAW AND ORDER**

Nothing could have offered a worse backdrop to the opening of the 79th UN General Assembly in New York this week than the news of the massive bombing campaign by Israel against the Iran-aligned Hezbollah in Lebanon. The pictures and live streaming clearly showed Israeli shells and missiles raining down on southern Lebanon — strikes that, in their first 24 hours, killed more than 500 people and injured hundreds more.

This backdrop of yet another flare-up of violence means the risk of an all-out war in the Middle East can be added to the list of other conflicts, adversities and challenges that are raging in our world. It maybe proves that the international order is broken and organizations such as the UN are becoming increasingly redundant, with trust between the big powers at an all-time low. We are now living in a more divided world that is split between the Western countries and their allies on one side and Russia alongside many countries in the so-called global majority, including China, on the other.

All diplomats are most probably working around the clock in New York in an attempt to de-escalate this and other conflicts, but the international organization, it seems, has become entangled in the global rift and therefore has little or no impact, either on Israel or Hezbollah.

It is unclear what progress can be made to defuse the situation in Lebanon, as efforts to broker a ceasefire in Gaza, which Israel has relentlessly pounded since October last year, have come to nothing over the past 11 months.

It has become clear over the past two decades that the UN as an organization, despite the crucial work of several of its agencies, is becoming irrelevant due to its failure to orchestrate, design and even impose peace.

The last time the world came together to solve a crisis was maybe the financial meltdown of 2008 and those efforts were led mainly by the G20, assisted by several UN agencies and other groupings. There were two key subsequent crises that indirectly sowed the seeds of discord within the international order. Firstly, the Libyan revolution against Muammar Qaddafi in 2011 and the subsequent UN resolution authorizing the use of force to protect civilians, which left key powers, namely Russia, feeling cheated. Moscow viewed the UN-authorized Western airstrikes on Libya as the catalyst that led to the downfall of Qaddafi's regime. Secondly, the inability of the UN and global powers to present a united front against the Syrian regime in that same period, even after the evident use of chemical and nonconventional weapons against its own people. That was another calamity that may have led to the further erosion of trust in the organization.

The strong words of UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres, who this week warned that impunity, inequality and uncertainty were creating an "unsustainable world," will no doubt go unheeded by states and people alike. The deepening geopolitical

divisions, wars with no end in sight, climate change, nuclear threats and unregulated tech continue to push humanity toward the “unimaginable — a powder keg that risks engulfing the world,” Guterres added.

But it is not just Israel’s war to dislodge Hamas from Gaza and its ramifications that are threatening peace and stability today. The Iran-backed “axis of resistance” in Lebanon, Iraq, Yemen and Syria have entered the fray and targeted Israel as a means of supporting Hamas. The Houthis of Yemen have been attacking shipping in the Red Sea with impunity, while the world has again failed to put forward a unified deterrence to help secure supply chains and world trade. The conflict in Sudan, which was high on last year’s UNGA agenda, continues to burn, alongside the Ukraine war, without any end in sight.

And that is just part of the usual story delegates at this annual meeting are shackled with, as global humanitarian needs continue to grow and the funds to meet them shrink, meaning some 2 billion people live in conflict-affected areas. Many of these decide to search for a better life as refugees or migrants in more stable countries, where they often become a burden and risk instability as a result of their large inflow.

Even the two-day “Summit of the Future,” held before the UNGA meetings, which was supposed to offer some respite and hope from the doom and gloom of our world, was nonbinding and lacked the impetus to rally nations to tackle the challenges of the 21st century, such as climate change, artificial intelligence, equality and women’s rights. Like many other initiatives, its blueprint is likely to become yet another document filed in the UN’s archives.

However, all is not lost just yet. While the world continues to hurtle toward greater discord and more conflicts like a train without any brakes, it is not unreasonable to demand a summit or a meeting that reviews the essence of the UN Charter. This document was endorsed at the San Francisco conference in 1945, but maybe it is time to see if those foundations, which served humanity after the Second World War, are still relevant today.

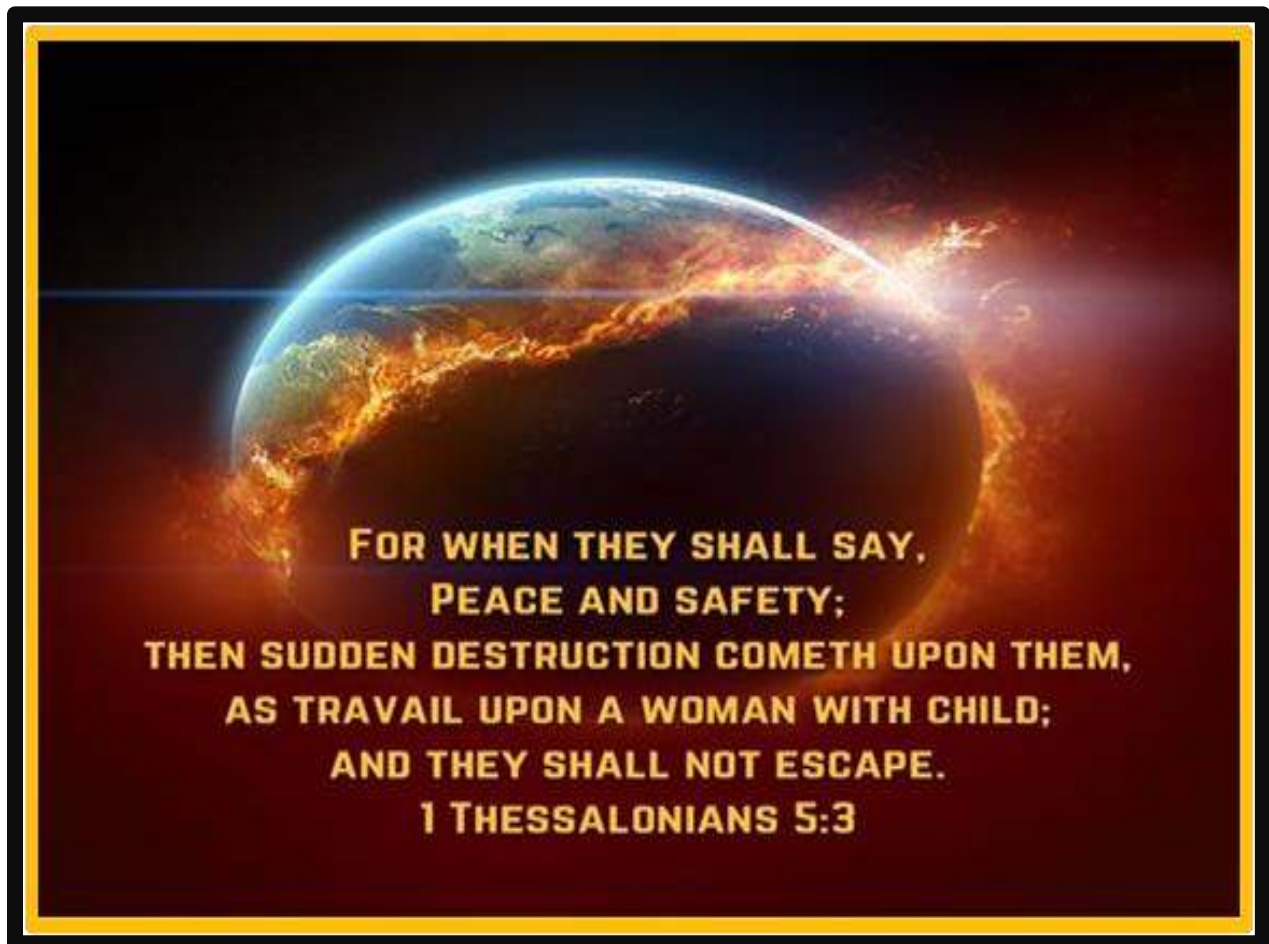
At the time the UN was born nearly 80 years ago, US President Harry Truman’s reversal of “might makes right” into “right makes might” was enshrined in the UN Charter. But such noble principles no longer feature in a world torn between its ultra-liberal and despotic forces, amid a clear return to “might makes right” as the

dominant narrative. If the UN, multilateralism and the craft of diplomacy are to have a second wind as a force for good, world leaders must renew their trust in the organization as a vehicle for ensuring peace, not just talking about it.

The UN has, for the best part of eight decades, been a talking shop for competing forces. To avert global conflicts and their catastrophic consequences today, an effective world body is needed to promote peace and prosperity. The aging UN could renew itself if the superpowers reached such a conclusion.

# SAUDI ARABIA'S GLOBAL POWER ON THE RISE

The concept of “power” in this article’s title refers to the recognition granted by various international forums to any country that possesses distinctive capabilities, thereby earning the label. Power is multidimensional. First, it denotes significant political influence. Second, it stems from economic strength that impacts multiple levels. Third, it encompasses a substantial spiritual role. This is not intended as mere flattery. However, even when viewed through this specific standpoint, it is essential to acknowledge when an entity succeeds where others, despite having all the necessary resources, have fallen short.

Recognizing people’s true worth is a fundamental principle. In this context, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, which celebrated its 94th National Day on Monday, has rightfully earned its position as a power to be reckoned with on the global stage. From the era of its founder, King Abdulaziz, to the leadership of King Salman and Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, Saudi kings have rejuvenated the nation, developed its vision and enhanced its capabilities over the years.

However, Saudi Arabia's rise as a global power has been marked by many confrontations. Internally, the Kingdom's path to modernization has been met with resistance from forces opposed to change in all fields. The most dangerous of those confrontations was — and still is — with movements that resist change for the better in all fields, especially that of human development. These forces, cloaking themselves in religious rhetoric, posed significant challenges to the Kingdom's forward momentum.

Saudi kings have rejuvenated the nation, developed its vision and enhanced its capabilities over the years

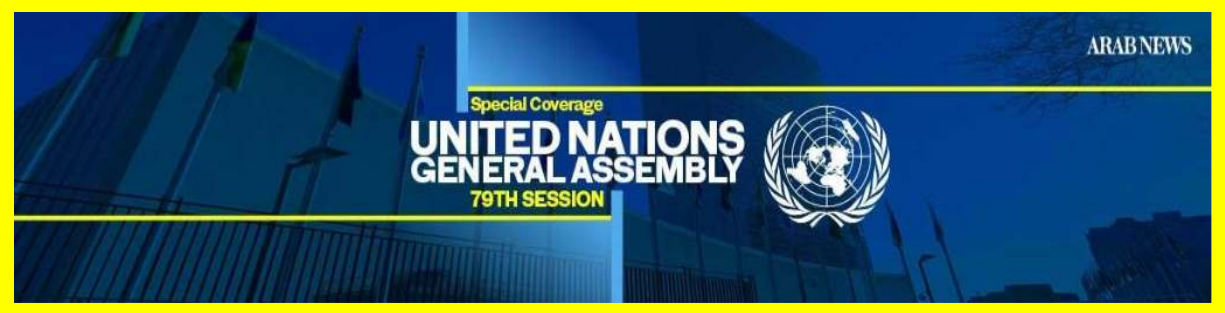

I, like many others of my generation, followed closely during the 1980s, 1990s and into the early 2000s the extent of the intellectual confrontations between progressive thinkers and those resistant to change. As for the Arab and Islamic levels, as well as the regional level, Saudi Arabia was destined to remain in near-constant confrontation with regional and international sides whose only intent is to disrupt its security and destabilize its people.

Saudi leaders have, however, effectively countered these threats to their people by maintaining focus on continuing to build the nation and upholding its place in the Arab world, as well as its international standing, without being swayed by the voices of skepticism that are primarily rejected by the Saudi people, who have confidence in the wisdom of their leadership.

However, the worst attempts to drive a wedge between Saudi citizens and their Arab neighbors and the Islamic extension of their affiliation were — and still are — those that use the Palestinian cause, people and tragedy to serve the purposes of malicious powers whose last concern is the suffering of the Palestinians. This situation has become more pronounced in recent months, since Benjamin Netanyahu's brutal war on the Gaza Strip and in the West Bank began.

Saudi Arabia's firm position on Palestine needs no defense and it is enough for the Saudi people and leadership to adhere to the true saying: "Respond to evil what is best. We know well what they claim," because, sooner or later, the truth will prevail.

## STAR OF JACOB TO APPEAR THIS MONTH

Scientists predict that a [nova](#) in the star system called T Coronae Borealis, or T CrB, will be visible to people on Earth in the next month. T CrB will **APPEAR 1,500 TIMES BRIGHTER THAN USUAL, MAKING IT THE 50TH BRIGHTEST STAR IN THE NIGHT SKY.** This nova may just be the **STAR OF JACOB, BALAAM DESCRIBED AS PRESAGING THE APPEARANCE OF THE MESSIAH.**

A nova is the temporary brightening of a star before it fades again, not to be confused with a supernova that occurs when a massive star explodes at the end of its life.

T CrB is a binary star system made up of a [red giant](#) and a white dwarf. They orbit each other every 228 days at about half the distance between Earth and the Sun. In this case, the earth-size white dwarf is slowly stripping hydrogen away from the ancient red giant. Once enough hydrogen accumulates on the white dwarf, the growing pressure and heat trigger a thermonuclear blast visible from Earth.

As T CrB is 2,630 light-years from Earth, light from the binary system requires 2,630 years to arrive at Earth. **THE NOVA WE WILL SEE OCCURRED OVER 2,000 YEARS AGO**, but its light will reach us next month.

## THE NEARING (7) OF JESUS' RETURN | YAHWEH'S FALL HOLY DAYS

T CrB is one of ten recurrent novae recorded that **ERUPT ON TIME SCALES OF LESS THAN A CENTURY. ON AVERAGE, T CRB UNDERGOES A NOVA PROCESS ONCE EVERY 80 YEARS.**



T CrB was first observed in the fall of 1217 by Burchard, abbot of Ursberg, Germany, who recorded “a faint star that for a time shone with great light.” Observations during its past two novae in 1866 and 1946 showed that T CrB became slightly brighter about ten years before the nova was visible from Earth. After brightening, the light from T CrB briefly dimmed, **INDICATING AN ERUPTION BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2024.**

Astronomers predict that the next nova event will occur between February and September. Scientists are excited as this will be the first outburst since modern spectroscopic observations have been available.

During the next Nova event, T CrB, also known as the Blaze Star, is expected to jump to second magnitude, making it similar in brightness to the North Star, Polaris. It could be visible to the naked eye for several days and potentially visible for over a week through binoculars before dimming and returning to obscurity. The next nova for T CrB **IS NOT EXPECTED FOR ANOTHER 80 YEARS, MAKING THIS A POTENTIAL ONCE-IN-A-LIFETIME ASTRONOMICAL EVENT.**

Efraim Palvanov, a teacher and author, writes the blog [Mayim Achronim](#) (Final Waters), named for the little-known Jewish ritual of washing the fingers after a

meal. Like the eponymous mitzvah, the blog covers Jewish subjects that are misunderstood or not normally discussed. In a recent lecture, [Palvanov described](#) the current wars in Ukraine and Israel as ***CONSISTENT WITH END-OF-DAYS PREDICTIONS RECORDED IN CLASSICAL JEWISH LITERATURE.***

Palvanov emphasized that he was not making a prediction or a prophecy but was ***DESCRIBING AN ASTRONOMICAL EVENT AS DESCRIBED IN JEWISH LITERATURE***

***“WE KNOW THAT PROBABLY ONE OF THE OLDEST PROPHECIES AND TRADITIONS ABOUT THE MOSHIACH (MESSIAH) comes from Balaam, a Gentile prophet who came to curse Israel but couldn’t curse them,”*** Palvanov said. ***“Instead, he gives a PROPHECY THAT ACTUALLY SAYS, ‘I WILL TELL YOU WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT THE END OF DAYS.’”***

***WHAT I SEE FOR THEM IS NOT YET, WHAT I BEHOLD WILL NOT BE SOON: A STAR RISES FROM YAAKOV, A SCEPTER COMES FORTH FROM YISRAEL; IT SMASHES THE BROW OF MOAB, THE FOUNDATION OF ALL CHILDREN OF SHET. NUMBERS 24:17***

“It’s one of the few places that the Torah ***USES THE EXPRESSION, ‘END OF DAYS,’***” Palvanov notes. ***“Balaam says that he is looking far into the future and he PROPHECIES THAT A STAR WILL EMERGE FROM JACOB. Of course, CHRISTIANS ADOPTED THIS IN THE NATIVITY SCENE AND THE STAR OF BETHLEHEM,”*** Palvanov added.

This verse was [interpreted](#) by Rabbi Moses ben Maimon, known as Maimonides, and by the acronym Rambam, the foremost Torah authority of the 12th century. In his book Mishneh Torah, the Rambam uses this verse about ***A STAR APPEARING AS PROOF THAT THE MESSIAH WILL COME ONE DAY. ACCORDING TO THE RAMBAM, THE MESSIAH WILL COME FROM JACOB, MORE SPECIFICALLY, FROM THE TRIBE OF JUDAH.***

Palvanov [explained that the prophecy of the Star of Jacob](#) was applied to Simon bar Kosiba, leader of the Second Jewish Revolt of 132 CE, whose adopted name, Bar Kochba, meant “Son of a Star” in Aramaic. The failure of the Bar Kochba revolt – which was considered a political Messiah – had a large impact on the interpretation of the Star of Jacob. The failure of the revolt led the sages to deemphasize the eschatology of the Star of Jacob. That led to a preference for the explanation that

the Star of Jacob was no longer relevant since **IT WAS DESCRIBED AS ALREADY HAPPENING IN THE TIME OF KING DAVID.**

**“THERE WAS ALWAYS, EVEN IN ANCIENT TIMES, AN ASSOCIATION OF MOSHIACH, OR A POTENTIAL MESSIAH WITH THE STAR OF JACOB. “BALAAM EVEN PROPHECIES THAT THIS STAR WILL MARK THE END OF AMALEK.” [ANTICHRIST].**

He saw Amalek and, taking up his theme, he said: **A LEADING NATION IS AMALEK; BUT ITS FATE IS TO PERISH FOREVER. NUMBERS 24:20**



The Zohar (212b) goes into detail, describing the Star of Jacob:

“It is taught that in the future, the Holy One, blessed be He, will rebuild Jerusalem and reveal one firm star, glowing with **SEVENTY PILLARS OF FIRE**, and with **SEVENTY SPARKS FLASHING** from it in the middle of the Firmament, and they will be reigned over by **SEVENTY OTHER STARS**, and they will **GLOW AND BURN FOR SEVENTY DAYS.**”

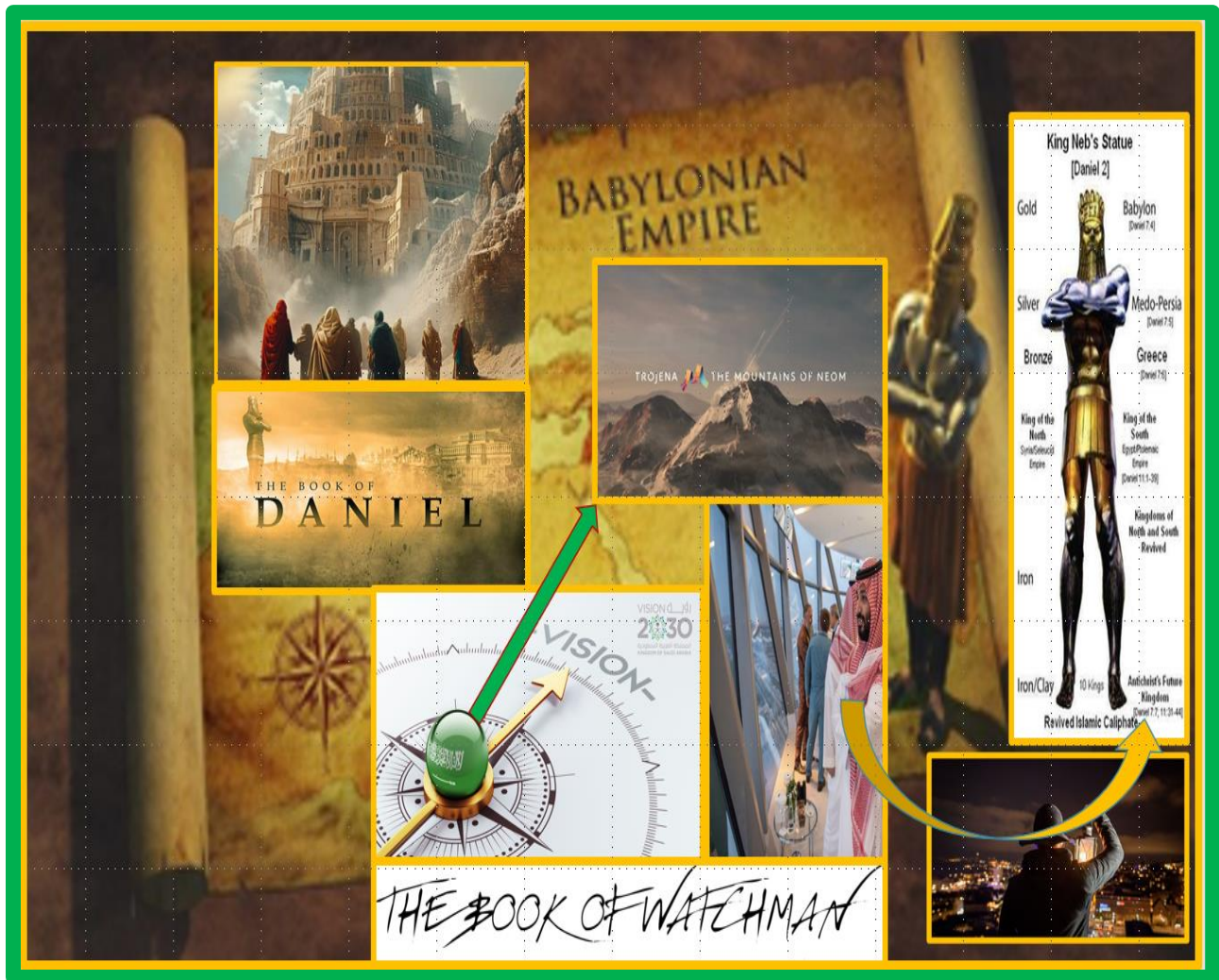
“And [the star] will be seen on the sixth day, on the 25th day of the sixth month. It will be **GATHERED ON THE SEVENTH DAY, AT THE END OF SEVENTY DAYS.** On the

An annular solar eclipse was visible along a path covering parts of the United States, Mexico, and several countries in Central America and South America on October 14, 2023, [exactly one week after the horrific attack](#) by Hamas on Israel.

When the three are aligned, an [eclipse](#) occurs when the moon passes between Earth and the sun. If the moon is close to Earth, then the lunar disk will completely block the sun in a total eclipse.

**A RING OF FIRE, REFERRED TO BY ASTRONOMERS AS AN ANNULAR SOLAR ECLIPSE,** occurs when the Moon passes between the Sun and the Earth while at its farthest point from the Earth. Hence the Sun appears as a very bright ring because the Moon doesn't completely cover the Sun (like in a total eclipse) and instead leaves a bright border. This is, essentially, the opposite of a supermoon, when the moon is close to the Earth, making it appear larger. Sunday's annular eclipse is especially rare as it comes in the summer.

The Earth's orbit around the Sun is elliptical, so its distance from the Sun varies throughout the year, affecting its apparent size. When Earth is at its farthest distance from the Sun in early July, a total eclipse is somewhat more likely. In contrast, conditions favor an annular eclipse when Earth approaches its closest distance to the Sun.

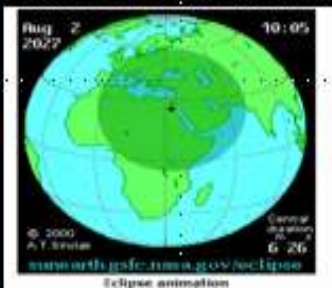

The same source in the Talmud specifies that ***LUNAR ECLIPSES ARE A BAD OMEN FOR ISRAEL SINCE ISRAEL IS SPIRITUALLY REPRESENTED BY THE MOON***. If the lunar eclipse takes place in the east side of the heavens, then it is a bad omen for all the nations in the east, and similarly, if it occurs in the western hemisphere of the sky, it is a bad sign for all the nations in the west.

A solar eclipse can only occur because the sun and the moon appear to be the same in diameter as seen from the earth. This is ***DUE TO A COINCIDENCE THAT IS UNIQUE AND HAS NOT BEEN FOUND ANYWHERE ELSE IN THE GALAXY***. Though ***THE SUN IS ABOUT 400 TIMES FARTHER AWAY THAN THE MOON, THE SUN IS ALSO ABOUT 400 TIMES BIGGER***. If the distances or sizes were different than they actually are, eclipses would not take place.

The Talmud relates to this, explaining why the sun and the moon appear to be the same size. The Talmud (Hulin 60b) discusses the seeming contradiction in the verse describing the creation of the sun and the moon.

***HASHEM MADE THE TWO GREAT LIGHTS, THE GREATER LIGHT TO DOMINATE THE DAY AND THE LESSER LIGHT TO DOMINATE THE NIGHT, AND THE STARS. [GENESIS 1:16](#)***

Though initially described in equal terms, the verse then noted the sun and the moon were not equal, with the sun being called the “greater light” and the moon the “lesser light”. The Talmud explains that when God created the sun and the moon they were equal in every manner, including size and intensity. The moon complained, saying, “Two kings cannot share one crown.” God agreed and made the moon shine less intensely, compensating the moon by commanding Israel to set the calendar by its cycles.

Jewish mysticism explains that this slight to the moon will be [rectified at the end of days](#) when the sun and the moon will be equal in both size and intensity.

# "COMET OF THE CENTURY" WILL BE VISIBLE FOR FIRST TIME IN 80,000 YEARS. HERE'S HOW TO GLIMPSE IT

The passing of a comet can bring feelings of either dread or wonder. ***A MYSTERIOUS CELESTIAL EVENT KNOWN AS THE STAR OF BETHLEHEM — WHICH WAS SAID TO HAVE ACCOMPANIED THE BIRTH OF JESUS CHRIST — COULD HAVE BEEN A COMET BECAUSE IT APPEARED SO SUDDENLY, STAYED FOR SO LONG AND WAS SEEN CROSSING THE SKY.*** More recently, science fiction movies like "[Deep Impact](#)" depict comets the size of Mount Everest on a collision course with Earth, ***PROMPTING MORE CONTEMPORARY CHARACTERIZATIONS OF APOCALYPTIC SCENARIOS.***

Yet throughout late September and mid-October, a person can watch a much-anticipated comet known as Tsuchinshan-ATLAS (official name: C/2023 A3) with neither religious awe nor fear of existential doom. The most important thing you'll need to know where to look and have a good view of the horizon, according to Nick Moskovitz, an astronomer at [Lowell Observatory](#) in Flagstaff, Arizona.

"It should be bright enough to see with the naked eye, kind of starting today through early next week before it gets too close to the Sun," Moskovitz told Salon. "It'll be visible as a very early morning comet. So you have to get up right before sunrise for maybe an hour or so, and look off to the eastern horizon. You need to be able to see a good vantage all the way to the eastern horizon. And again, about an hour before sunrise, you may be able to see it."

This will be helpful [throughout the weekend](#), but by Monday folks in the northern hemisphere will not be able to easily spot Tsuchinshan-ATLAS again for the next few days. The good news for them is that, around Oct. 12, Tsuchinshan-ATLAS is expected to be visible again all over the planet.

According to [Astronomy Magazine](#), it may be a "more productive option" for northern hemispheric stargazers to plan on catching Tsuchinshan-ATLAS both this weekend and in mid-October, since the latter occasion could prove more fortuitous. After passing within the boundaries of the constellation Virgo, Tsuchinshan-ATLAS will go on a trajectory through Serpens and the constellation Ophiuchus before eventually, on Oct. 28th, lying just south of the second-brightest star in the constellation Ophiuchus, magnitude 2.8 Cebalrai. ***SOME ARE PREDICTING IT WILL BE SO BRIGHT, IT COULD BE THE "COMET OF THE CENTURY."***

Yet this is not to say that it will be easy to spot Tsuchinshan-ATLAS on any of these occasions — at least without a trusty pair of binoculars or low-powered telescope. Moskovitz ruefully noted that the comet can be "pretty hard to see, actually,

because it's essentially a daytime comet, which means as it gets brighter over the next few weeks, it's going to be close to the Sun. The Sun, as you might imagine, acts as a big source of glare that makes it hard to see small and faint things nearby."

Despite these disadvantages, stargazers should count their blessings. ***THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT TSUCHINSHAN-ATLAS WILL BE VISIBLE WITHOUT A TELESCOPE IN 80,000 YEARS, WHICH IS HOW LONG IT TAKES TO ORBIT THE SUN.*** It has likely been around for a long time, which makes comets like this even more intriguing to astronomers.

"Comets are really interesting because they're kind of what we think of as pristine relics of the ancient solar system," Moskovitz said. "Back before there were even planets around the Sun, there were what we would call planetesimals, the very building blocks that created and built up the planets that we have today. And ***COMETS ARE SOME OF THESE LEFTOVER RELICS OF THAT TIME IN THE VERY EARLY ERA OF THE SOLAR SYSTEM.*** So by studying objects like this comet, we can understand what the conditions were like when they formed and what kind of materials were involved."

Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman (MBS), de facto chief executive of Saudi Arabia, on Wednesday condemned the “crimes of the Israeli occupation” against Palestinians.

“The Palestinian cause is a top priority for Saudi Arabia, and we reiterate the kingdom’s rejection and strong condemnation of the crimes committed by the Israeli occupation authorities against the Palestinian people, in disregard of international and humanitarian law in a new and bitter chapter of suffering,” he [said](#).

“The kingdom will not stop its tireless work towards the establishment of an independent Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital, and we affirm that the kingdom will not establish diplomatic relations with Israel without that,” he declared.

“We extend our thanks to the countries that recognised the Palestinian state in embodiment of international legitimacy, and we urge the rest of the countries to take similar steps,” he said.

The crown prince, known by his initials MBS, made his [remarks](#) in his annual address to the Consultative Assembly of Saudi Arabia, more commonly [called](#) the Shura Council.

The Shura Council is a 150-member quasi-legislative body whose members are chosen by the monarchy from the ranks of scholars and experts in various fields. The council is technically only an advisory body for the king, who can dismiss any of its members or dissolve the council entirely if he pleases, but it has been given more responsibilities under reforms that began in 2004.

The current king of Saudi Arabia, Salman bin Abdulaziz al-Saud, is 88 years old and in frail health, so his 39-year-old heir MBS has handled the past few annual speeches to the Shura Council. The members of the Council swear a formal oath of allegiance to the monarchy at the end of the yearly royal address.

MBS’ comments were not unexpected given the political and religious dimensions of the Hamas-Israel war.

When former President Donald Trump [brokered](#) the September 2020 Abraham Accords, under which Bahrain and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) normalized relations with Israel, there were hopes Saudi Arabia might join. The Accords seemed to break the longstanding Middle Eastern stalemate that Arab nations would never recognize Israel until it gave up territory for a Palestinian state.

A few other states [joined](#) the Abraham Accords, such as Sudan, Morocco, and Kosovo, but the grand prize of Saudi Arabia remained elusive. The Biden administration, seemingly determined to return to Barack Obama's bizarre pro-Iranian foreign policy and unwilling to credit Trump for changing the political situation in the Middle East, left the Accords to wither. President Joe Biden made a point of personally antagonizing MBS, sending U.S.-Saudi relations on a downward spiral.

Just two weeks before Hamas attacked Israel on October 7, MBS [said](#) his country was making progress toward normalization with Israel. "Every day we get closer," he said.

Even then, MBS insisted the "Palestinian issue is very important," but not quite in such adamant terms as he used on Wednesday.

"We got to see where we go. We hope that will reach a place that will ease the life of the Palestinians and get Israel as a player in the Middle East," he said.

MBS cultivated a reputation as a bold reformer, alongside accusations of authoritarianism and repression from his critics. He [touted](#) his reform achievements in his speech to the Shura Council, including progress on his plan to diversify the Saudi economy away from complete reliance upon oil.

Those hosannas to reform and progress came right before the Crown Prince demanded Palestinian statehood and lowered the boom on normalization with Israel.

The Biden administration downplayed progress toward Saudi-Israeli normalization before the October 7 attack, but lately it has been trying to raise hopes of a deal before Biden formally leaves office.

“I think if we can get a ceasefire in Gaza, there remains an opportunity through the balance of this administration to move forward on normalization,” Secretary of State Antony Blinken [said](#) during a visit to Haiti on September 6.

Blinken has also said normalization would require “calm in Gaza and a credible pathway to a Palestinian state.” The Saudi chief executive’s comments on Wednesday suggest he will insist on reaching the end of that “credible pathway” before making a deal, which means the deal will not be struck with Joe Biden nominally in the White House.

[Saudi Arabia](#)'s Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman told [US](#) Secretary of State Antony Blinken that he does not personally care about what he referred to as the "Palestinian issue", according to a [report](#) in The Atlantic.

Published on Wednesday, the report gave a picture of 11 months of Washington's negotiation efforts in the region after the outbreak of war in Gaza, citing "two dozen participants at the highest levels of government in America and across the Middle East".

It stated that during a visit to Saudi Arabia in January, Blinken and the crown prince met in the Saudi city of al-Ula to discuss the prospect of the Gulf kingdom normalising relations with Israel amid the ongoing Israeli war on Gaza. Months earlier, Riyadh had appeared to be making progress in forming ties with [Israel](#) during US-led discussions, which were later derailed by the outbreak of war on 7 October.

If a normalisation deal were to occur, the crown prince expressed to Blinken a desire for calm in Gaza.

According to The Atlantic, Blinken enquired whether the Saudis could tolerate Israel periodically re-entering the territory to strike the besieged Gaza Strip.

"They can come back in six months, a year, but not on the back end of my signing something like this," Mohammed bin Salman responded.

"Seventy percent of my population is younger than me," the crown prince explained to Blinken.

"For most of them, they never really knew much about the Palestinian issue. And so they're being introduced to it for the first time through this conflict. It's a huge problem. Do I care personally about the Palestinian issue? I don't, but my people do, so I need to make sure this is meaningful."

No deal without a Palestinian state

A Saudi official described this account of the conversation to The Atlantic as "incorrect".

In public, Mohammed bin Salman has [stated](#) that Saudi Arabia will not normalise relations with Israel without the establishment of a Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital.

"The Kingdom will not cease its diligent efforts to establish an independent Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital," he said at a recent annual address before the Shura Council in Riyadh.

"We confirm that Saudi Arabia will not establish diplomatic relations with Israel until that goal is achieved."

According to The Atlantic, in return for a normalisation deal with Israel, Saudi Arabia would seek to enter into a mutual defence treaty with Washington.

That would require ratification from two-thirds of the US Senate, which the crown prince told Blinken was most likely under a Biden administration. That was partly due to a perception that US progressives may back it if a Palestinian state was built into the deal.

Mohammed bin Salman told Blinken that pursuing a normalisation deal with Israel would come at great personal cost to him. He pointed at the example of [Egyptian](#) President Anwar Sadat, who was assassinated in 1981, a few years after signing a peace accord with Israel.

“Half my advisers say that the deal is not worth the risk,” the de-facto Saudi leader said. “I could end up getting killed because of this deal.”

Polling during the early stages of the war showed that over 90 percent of Saudis [believed](#) that Arab states should cut ties with Israel.

Despite that, there has been a crackdown on acts of Palestinian solidarity in Saudi Arabia, with reports of people being detained for [expressing opinions](#) on the conflict on social media, as well as for [wearing a Palestinian keffiyeh](#) in the holy city of Mecca.

### **'FULL SUPPORT FOR PALESTINE'**

Earlier this month, Middle East Eye [asked](#) senior Saudi royal Prince Turki al-Faisal about the crackdown on Palestinian solidarity in the kingdom.

“I haven’t felt myself any restrictions on my expressions of support for Palestine in Saudi Arabia, nor have I seen any particular reporting on that,” he responded. “Except perhaps in some publications that are not friendly to Saudi Arabia.

“But what I see of the Saudi press, whether written or on television or in social media, is full support for Palestine and no restriction on expressing support for Palestinians.”

Prince Turki said that while he was not privy to official discussions, the chances of normalisation at present were slim due to Israel’s stance on Palestinian statehood.

“The whole [Israeli] government is saying no Palestinian state. So how can there be normalisation between us and them with those positions in place?”

Prince Turki also dismissed speculation that Hamas may have carried out its surprise attack on southern Israel - which killed around 1,140 people - in order to torpedo Saudi-Israel normalisation.

## EUROPEANS, ARAB AND MUSLIM NATIONS LAUNCH A NEW INITIATIVE FOR AN INDEPENDENT PALESTINIAN STATE

UNITED NATIONS (AP) — European, Arab and Islamic nations have launched an initiative to strengthen support for a Palestinian state and its institutions, and prepare for a future after the [war in Gaza](#) and escalating conflict in Lebanon, Norway's foreign minister said Friday.

Espen Barth Eide told The Associated Press that “there is a growing consensus in the international community from Western countries, from Arab countries, from the Global South, that we need to establish a Palestinian Authority, a Palestinian government, a Palestinian state — and the [Palestinian state has to be recognized.](#)”

Eide said many issues need to be addressed, including the security interests of Israel and the Palestinians, recognition and normalization of relations after decades of conflict and the demobilization of  [Hamas as a military group](#).

“These are pieces of a bigger puzzle,” Norway's chief diplomat said. “And you can't just come in there with one of these pieces, because it only works if all the pieces are laid in place.”

Traction with Netanyahu is unlikely

But even if the puzzle is completed, it's [unlikely to gain traction](#) with Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Still, Eide believes that after decades of failed or stalled negotiations, “we need to take a new approach” to achieving an independent Palestinian state.

To accelerate work on these issues, Eide said almost 90 countries attended a meeting Thursday on the sidelines of the [U.N. General Assembly's current gathering](#) of world leaders. He and Saudi Arabia's foreign minister co-chaired the session to launch “The Global Alliance for the Implementation of a Palestinian State and a Two-State Solution.”

“We have to see how we can come out of this deadlock and try to use this deep crisis also as an opportunity to move forward,” Eide told a U.N. Security Council meeting on Gaza later Friday.

Norway is the guarantor of the 1993 Oslo Accords, hailed as a breakthrough in the decades-long conflict between Arabs and Jews, which created the Palestinian Authority and set up [self-rule areas in the Palestinian Authority](#). Eide said more than 30 years later, Israel’s “occupation” is continuing, and there there are no negotiations leading to a final settlement and an independent Palestinian state — which led to Norway’s decision in May to [recognize a Palestinian state](#).

Now, 149 of the U.N.’s 193 member nations have recognized a Palestinian state. Eide urged all countries “to contribute to universal recognition” and strengthen Palestinian institutions so they live up to the expectations of people in the West Bank and are prepared to return to Gaza: “We want one Palestine, not different Palestines,” he said.

Saudi Foreign Minister Prince Faisal bin Farhan Al-Saud told the U.N. Security Council on Friday that his country, the joint Islamic-Arab ministerial committee, Norway and the European Union launched the alliance “because we feel responsible to act to change the reality of the conflict without delay.”

EU foreign policy chief Josep Borrell urged all countries to take practical measures “to bring about the free Palestine next to a secure Israel.”

First meetings will be in Saudi Arabia and Belgium

Borrell said on X that the first meetings of the alliance would be in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, and Brussels. Borrell asked rhetorically of anyone who [opposes a two-state solution](#): What is the solution, and can it be implemented? He stressed that work on this initiative will move ahead quickly.

Eide said this new effort is built on the 2002 Arab Peace Initiative, “but updated to today’s reality.”

The 2002 initiative, endorsed by the Arab League and the 57-member Organization of Islamic Cooperation, offered Israel normalized relations in exchange for a full withdrawal from territories captured in 1967.

He said efforts started long ago to build the institutions of a Palestinian state.

“It’s difficult,” Eide said. “Their hands are tied in many ways. We’re seeing an increasing amount of illegal settlements and settle violence.”

“But still, there is an embryonic institution there that we have to strengthen,” he said.

Eide said he chaired a meeting Thursday of the Ad Hoc Liaison Committee for the Building of Palestinian Institutions, with the United States, Canada, the EU and many Mideast and European countries contributing.

“None of these tools will solve the problem on their own, and we never pretended that, but we’re trying to build a body of instruments that will take us forward to a peaceful settlement,” Eide said. “And I am convinced it will happen here.”

## SAUDI CROWN PRINCE SAYS NO NORMALISATION WITH ISRAEL WITHOUT PALESTINIAN STATEHOOD

Bin Salman also denounces 'Israeli occupation crimes' and violations of international humanitarian law in his annual speech to lawmakers

[Saudi Arabia](#) will not normalise relations with Israel without the establishment of a Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital, Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman said on Wednesday.

"The Kingdom will not cease its diligent efforts to establish an independent Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital," he said at an annual [address](#) before the Shura Council in Riyadh.

"We confirm that Saudi Arabia will not establish diplomatic relations with Israel until that goal is achieved."

Bin Salman, who is also Saudi Arabia's prime minister, said his government condemns "crimes" committed by Israel in violation of international law.

"The Palestinian cause is a top priority for Saudi Arabia, and we reiterate the kingdom's rejection and strong condemnation of the crimes committed by the Israeli occupation authorities against the Palestinian people, in disregard of international and humanitarian law in a new and bitter chapter of suffering," he said.

"We extend our thanks to the countries that recognised the Palestinian state in embodiment of international legitimacy, and we urge the rest of the countries to take similar steps," he added.

Saudi Arabia and Israel had been making progress on normalisation of ties prior to the 7 October Hamas-led attack on Israel and the subsequent Israeli onslaught on Gaza. Weeks before 7 October, Bin Salman [said](#) that the kingdom's ties with Israel

were getting closer "every day" amid [apparent signs](#) of de facto normalisation in various areas including defence and technology.

Talks on normalisation of ties between Saudi Arabia and Israel had been spearheaded by the administration of US President Joe Biden following the success of deals with the [United Arab Emirates](#), [Bahrain](#), [Morocco](#) and [Sudan](#) in 2020 and 2021, part of the accords brokered by then US President Donald Trump.

Saudi officials have repeatedly emphasised that Palestinian statehood was one of the conditions during normalisation talks.

Prince Khalid bin Bandar, the Saudi ambassador in London, said in January that a normalisation deal was "close" but the kingdom paused US-brokered talks after the 7 October attack.

"We were close to normalisation, therefore close to a Palestinian state. One doesn't come without the other. The sequencing, how it is managed, that is what was being discussed," the diplomat added.

The Saudi [foreign ministry](#) also said in February that no normalisation will take place without a ceasefire and progress toward Palestinian statehood.

Yet US Secretary of State Antony Blinken [said](#) in April that Washington and Riyadh have engaged in intensive diplomacy since 7 October to reach the normalisation deal and that an agreement was nearing "completion".

Despite official comments supporting Palestinian statehood, the Saudi government has reportedly [suppressed](#) criticism of Israel on social media networks, with several people detained for posts about the conflict.

## SAUDI-ISRAELI DEAL 'CLOSER EVERY DAY', SAYS MOHAMMED BIN SALMAN

A normalisation agreement between [Saudi Arabia](#) and [Israel](#) is getting closer "every day", Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman said on Wednesday during a rare interview with English-speaking media.

"For us, the Palestinian issue is very important. We need to solve that part," he told Fox News. "We hope that will reach a place, that it will ease the life of the Palestinians, get Israel as a player in the Middle East."

The crown prince also described the killing of Saudi journalist [Jamal Khashoggi](#), which he is accused of ordering, as "a mistake".

For months, the United States has been leading efforts to strike a deal between Saudi Arabia and Israel that would establish formal ties.

Saudi Arabia has held out the offer to normalise ties with Israel since 2002 under the Arab Peace Plan, which calls for an independent [Palestinian](#) state in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, with East Jerusalem as its capital.

Asked if recent talks had been suspended, Mohammed bin Salman denied recent reports, stating: "Every day we get closer."

Fox News said it was the the crown prince's first interview with a major American broadcaster since 2019. It was also the first wide-ranging discussion to be carried out entirely in English.

The sit-down took place in [Sindalah](#), a new Red Sea island resort built as part of the Neom megacity project.

The crown prince signalled that Saudi Arabia would obtain a nuclear weapon if Iran did too.

"We are concerned if any country getting a nuclear weapon... that's a bad move," he said. "They don't need to get nuclear weapon because you cannot use it."

"The world cannot see another Hiroshima. If the world sees 100,000 people dead that mean you are in a war with the rest of the world."

But he added that if Iran were to get one, "we will have to get one, for security reasons, for balancing power".

Riyadh and Tehran have had a [tumultuous relationship](#) dating back to Iran's Islamic Revolution in 1979, but officially restored ties after years of animosity during [China](#)-brokered talks in March.

### KHASHOGGI AND HUMAN RIGHTS

Ahead of the ***FIVE-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF THE MURDER OF MIDDLE EAST EYE AND WASHINGTON POST COLUMNIST JAMAL KHASHOGGI, THE CROWN PRINCE DESCRIBED THE INCIDENT AS A "MISTAKE".***

Khashoggi was murdered by Saudi agents at the kingdom's Istanbul consulate in 2018. The CIA concluded that the crown prince had signed off the operation, an allegation Riyadh denies.

"We take all the legal measurements that any country took," Mohammed bin Salman said.

"Also, we try to reform the security system to be sure that these kind of mistakes doesn't happen again, and we can see in the past five years nothing of those things happened. It's not part of what Saudi Arabia do."

He claimed that all those who were involved had served jail time.

Earlier this year, Saud al-Qahtani, a former senior aide to the crown prince and prime suspect in Khashoggi's murder, was [seen in public](#) for the first time since the assassination.

Qahtani was banned from entering the US, the [UK](#) and other European countries, and was among the [17 Saudis sanctioned by the US](#) Treasury over Khashoggi's murder, based on intelligence reports that he was involved in the operation.

The de-facto Saudi leader was also asked to confirm reports that [Mohammed al-Ghamdi](#), a retired teacher, was sentenced to death for remarks made on Twitter and YouTube to a handful of followers.

"Shamefully, it's true. It's something I don't like," he said, adding that he wanted to change some of Saudi Arabia's laws.

"We are not happy with that. We are ashamed of that. But [under] the jury system, you have to follow the laws and I cannot tell a judge [to] do that and ignore the law, because... that's against the rule of law," he added.

"But do we have bad laws? Yes. We are changing that, yes."

Pressed on whether he expected Ghamdi to be executed, the crown prince said he hoped the judge would be "more experienced" and look at it "totally differently".

Mohammed bin Salman also defended the Saudi Public Investment Fund's decision to invest \$2bn in Jared Kushner's firm Affinity Partners.

He said that in the event that Kushner's father-in-law, Donald Trump, was re-elected, the investment would likely remain intact.

"If it's not legal, then, definitely, we have to work it out, but if it's legal, what's the problem?" he said.

### 'I WILL CONTINUE DOING SPORTSWASHING'

The crown prince swatted away criticism about Saudi Arabia's increased investment in sports, which have been deemed by some as an attempt to "sportswash" the country's reputation.

"If sportswashing [is] going to increase my GDP by way of one percent, then I will continue doing sportswashing," he said.

"I don't care. One percent growth of GDP from sport and I'm aiming for another one and a half percent - call it whatever you want, we're going to get that one and a half percent."

## UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY 2024: DIPLOMATS WALK OUT IN PROTEST AGAINST NETANYAHU ADDRESS

Scores of diplomats walked out of [Israeli](#) Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's speech at the United Nations General Assembly on Friday, in protest against the devastating [war on Gaza](#) and the latest Israeli [attacks](#) on Lebanon.

Several diplomats could be seen walking out in haste as Netanyahu entered the great hall to speak from the rostrum, with the presiding diplomat having to shout "order, please" as the Israeli leader took to the stage.

The war on Gaza, now approaching its one-year mark, has turned much of the enclave into an uninhabitable hellscape.

More than 42,000 people have been killed, almost the entire population are reported to have fled their homes at least once, and those in northern Gaza are on the verge of famine.

Meanwhile, whole neighbourhoods and families have been erased, with homes, schools and hospitals devastated by air strikes and tank fire.

Despite the bloodbath, Israel has sought to expand the war, and in the past week has been relentlessly bombing Lebanon, killing more than 700 people, including scores of women and children.

Visibly angry due to the mass walkout, Netanyahu defended his response to the 7 October Hamas-led attacks on southern Israel and the recent escalatory attacks on Lebanon.

"Israel has every right to remove this threat and return our citizens to their home safely. And that's exactly what we're doing," Netanyahu said. "We will not rest until the remaining hostages are brought home."

Netanyahu's speech was also replete with dire warnings that there could be more carnage to come.

"I have a message for the tyrants of Tehran: if you strike us, we will strike you," he said. "There is no place no place in Iran that the long arm of Israel cannot reach and that's true of the entire Middle East."

Tensions between Israel and Iran have been on the rise since Israel attacked Iran's embassy complex in Damascus earlier this year and assassinated Hamas's political chief Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran.

Iranian officials have said that Tehran reserves the right to retaliate at their chosen time and place.

Throughout the week, world leaders have been calling for an end to the fighting, with several of them, including US President Joe Biden, reiterating calls for a ceasefire.

Netanyahu, however, seemed to pour cold water on the idea, telling the UN that his military would keep striking Lebanon with "all our might".

"We're at war with Hezbollah," he said. "As long as Hezbollah chooses the path of war, Israel has no choice. And Israel has every right to remove this threat and return our citizens to their homes safely."

Two hours after Netanyahu spoke, Israeli fighter jets carried out a series of air strikes on Beirut's southern suburbs, a densely-populated area colloquially known as Dahiyeh, in what appeared to be the most intense bombardment of the Lebanese capital since the 2006 war.

Videos seen by Middle East Eye showed at least four flattened residential buildings with extensive damage to nearby structures.

The Israeli army claimed it targeted Hezbollah headquarters, which were allegedly located under residential buildings, and Israeli media claimed that the group's leader, Hassan Nasrallah, was the target of the attack.

Iran's Tasnim news agency, which is affiliated to the Revolutionary Guards, quoted security sources as saying Nasrallah was in a "safe place and what is published in the Hebrew media is not true."

MEE could not independently verify the claims.

Israel's wars in the Middle East have been one of the main topics of conversation since world leaders descended on New York City.

On Thursday, Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas challenged Israel's "lies" and asked who was responsible for the killing of 15,000 Palestinian children, if not Israel.

"Stop this crime. Stop this now. Stop killing children and women. Stop the genocide. Stop sending weapons to Israel. This madness cannot continue. The entire world is responsible for what is happening to our people in Gaza and the West Bank," he said.



## **SAUDI CABINET WELCOMES UNGA RESOLUTION ON ENDING ILLEGAL OCCUPATION IN PALESTINIAN TERRITORIES**

The Saudi cabinet, chaired by King Salman, welcomed the recent United Nations General Assembly resolution calling for an end to the illegal occupation of Palestinian territories, the Saudi Press Agency reported on Tuesday.

The UN General Assembly passed a resolution urging Israel to end its illegal occupation of Palestinian territories within a year. The vote was 124-14, with 43 abstentions

The cabinet also emphasized the need for practical and credible steps toward a just and comprehensive solution to the Palestinian issue, in accordance with the Arab Peace Initiative and international legitimacy resolutions.

Addressing global developments, the council reaffirmed Saudi Arabia's commitment to enhancing regional and international security, supporting political resolutions to global crises, and promoting multilateral cooperation to tackle global challenges.

During the session, King Salman expressed his appreciation to international leaders for their well wishes on the occasion of Saudi Arabia's 94th National Day.

In environmental leadership, the cabinet celebrated Saudi Arabia's election to the presidency of the Global Coral Reef Initiative, a recognition of the Kingdom's efforts in protecting marine biodiversity and ecosystems.



## **INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY HAS ‘MORAL DUTY’ TO PROTECT PALESTINIANS: JORDAN’S KING**

DUBAI: The international community has a “moral duty” to “establish a protection mechanism” for Palestinians “across the Occupied Territories,” Jordan’s King Abdullah told the UN General Assembly on Tuesday.

He also condemned “those who continue to propagate the idea of Jordan as an alternative homeland” for Palestinians. “Let me be very, very clear: That will never happen.”

The king said no country in the region benefits from escalation, adding: “We’ve seen that clearly in the dangerous developments in Lebanon over the past few days. This has to stop.

“For years, the Arab world has extended a hand to Israel through the Arab Peace Initiative, offering full recognition and normalization in exchange for peace. “But consecutive Israeli governments, emboldened by years of impunity, have rejected peace and chosen confrontation instead.”

The UN “is facing a crisis that strikes at its very legitimacy and threatens a collapse of global trust and moral authority. The UN is under attack, literally and figuratively,” said the king, adding that for nearly a year, the organization has been powerless to protect innocent civilians from Israeli bombardment of its shelters and schools in Gaza.

UN aid trucks sit motionless just miles away from starving Palestinians, its workers are disparaged and targeted, and the rulings of the UN’s International Court of Justice “are defied and its opinions are disregarded,” he said. “So it’s no surprise that both inside and outside this hall, trust in the UN’s cornerstone principles and ideals is crumbling.”

He said many people see that some nations are above international law and that human rights are selective.

Addressing the UNGA, he said: “Ask yourselves, if we aren’t nations united in the conviction that all people are equal in rights, dignity and worth, and that all countries are equal in the eyes of the law, what kind of world does that leave us with?”

He reminded the audience that the Oct. 7 Hamas attack against Israel was condemned by countries all over the world, including Jordan. “But the unprecedented scale of terror unleashed on Gaza since that day is beyond any justification,” the king said.

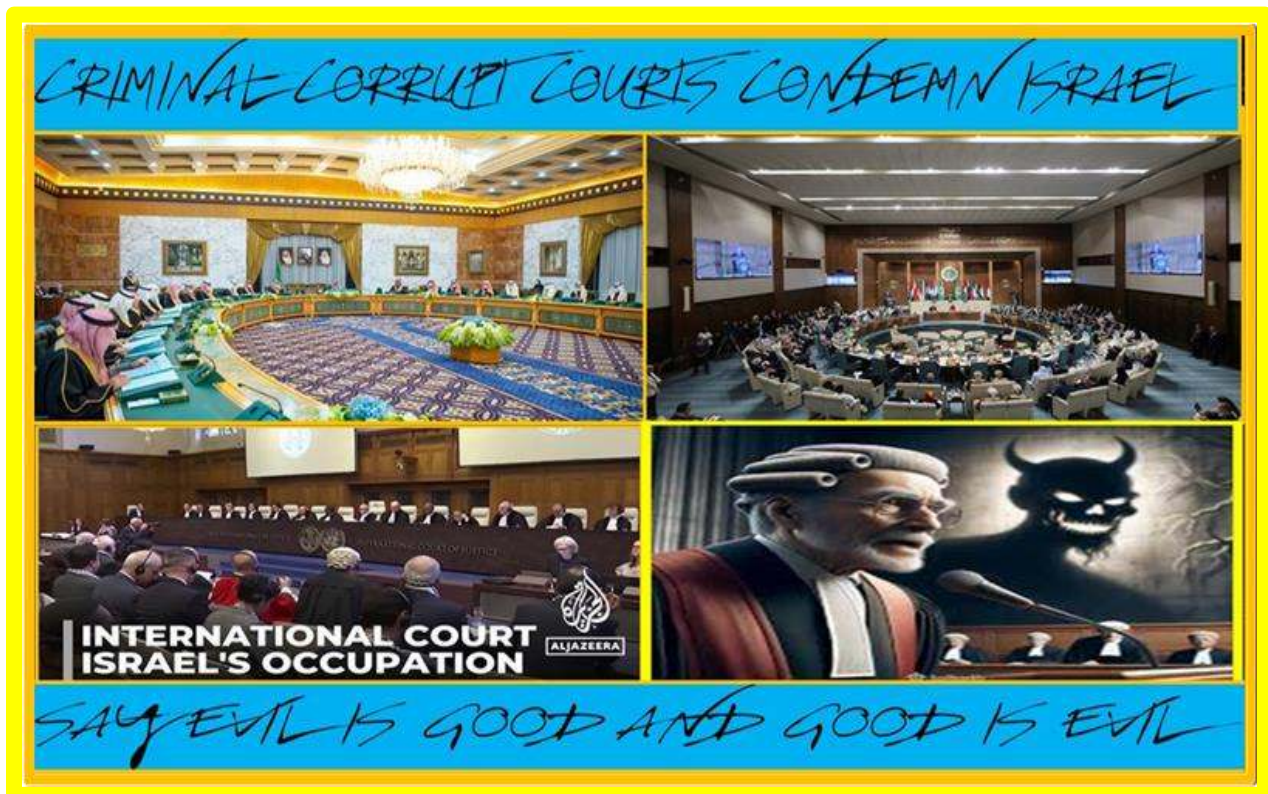

Likewise, there has been speculation that the prospect of a new, significant, and enduring defense alliance between the United States and Saudi Arabia has been seriously diminished.

But ALL ARAB NEWS can report that such rumors are wrong.

I'll explain why in a moment — first, some context.

### **A LONG, HOT, CRUEL SUMMER**

Earlier this year, a deal to achieve both looked imminent.

The Biden team had invested hundreds of hours in behind the scenes negotiations both on the Saudi-Israeli front, and on hashing out the terms of a US-Saudi defense pact that could be confirmed by the Senate.

But several factors detailed both.

First, it's been a long, hot, cruel summer on the media front. Constant images on Al Jazeera and other regional TV networks showing the pain and destruction in Gaza and southern Lebanon have fueled growing grassroots anger in the Arab world against Israel.

Second, the implosion of President Joe Biden's presidential campaign after his disastrous performance in the July debate with former President Donald J. Trump meant that everyone in the White House had to focus on damage control and then on helping Vice President Kamala Harris secure her party's nomination once Biden announced his withdrawal from the campaign.

The third factor was the determination, unsuccessful though they have been, of Secretary of State Tony Blinken and CIA Director Bill Burns to forge a back channel deal to get the hostages out of Gaza.

There simply hasn't been any additional bandwidth at the White House, in the State Department, or at Langley to focus on anything else.

### **MBS IS UNDETERRED**

ALL ARAB NEWS has learned, however, from well-placed sources in the Biden-Harris administration, Congress, and in the Arab world that Riyadh is undeterred.

The Saudi leadership has not given up.

To the contrary, precisely due to the explosion of Iranian aggression and violence in the region —and the fact that Tehran is right on the verge of a nuclear weapons breakout — Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman (MBS) is more determined than ever to finalize an historic defense alliance with the United States and an historic normalization agreement with Israel.

He wants a NATO-esque regional alliance against the Iranian regime and its terrorist proxy forces.

He also urgently wants to help restore calm in the region that will be good for business, trade, tourism, and economic growth.

### THE PALESTINIAN FACTOR

To be sure, MBS also wants to help the Palestinians chart a realistic pathway forward to build a free, safe, and prosperous post-war society in the Gaza Strip.

Indeed, the de facto ruler of Saudi Arabia sees this as a necessary step towards the creation of a peaceful and prosperous Palestinian state that links Gaza with the West Bank but doesn't endanger the security of Egypt, Jordan, or Israel.

What's more, given such deep and widespread sympathy for the Palestinian people throughout the kingdom and the rest of the Arab/Muslim world, the Saudis are actively working behind the scenes with a range of other Arab countries in plans to radically reform the Palestinian Authority and rebuild Gaza once the war is over.

But any speculation that MBS has abandoned his goal of striking a grand bargain with the Americans and Israelis that he believes will dramatically advance core Saudi national interests — including guarding the kingdom from Iranian aggression — is entirely off base, I'm told.

### **TRUMP OR HARRIS? RIYADH READY FOR EITHER**

The big question that the Saudis — and every government in the Middle East and North Africa— are asking is this: Who will be the next President of the United States, Donald J. Trump or Kamala Harris?

The Saudis are not taking sides, of course.

They have much more experience with Trump.

They have less direct and detailed experience with Harris.

But they are hoping that whoever wins will want some big foreign policy wins — especially in the Middle East — and quickly.

From my vantage point, I would say that Riyadh is signaling to all sides that they stand ready to deliver.

## HARRIS' 'TWO-STATE SOLUTION' WOULD 'WIPE ISRAEL OFF THE MAP'

It's been almost a year since the Hamas terrorist organization attacked Israel on Oct. 7. The massacre left over 1,200 people dead and over 200 kidnapped—including women, men, and children. Since the attack, the Biden administration has made its support for a two-state solution clear. And now, with [Vice President Kamala Harris](#) running as the 2024 Democratic presidential nominee, it appears nothing has changed.

During Tuesday's debate between the vice president and the Republican presidential nominee [Donald Trump](#), Harris restated her support for a cease-fire and two-state solution, which, as Family Research Council President Tony Perkins explained on Thursday's episode of "[Washington Watch](#)," would ultimately "transfer the geographical heart of the state of Israel, Judea and Samaria, to the Palestinians."

Harris declared, "We must chart a course for a two-state solution, and in that solution, there must be security for the Israeli people and Israel and an equal

measure for the Palestinians.” But experts on the ground in Israel like Caroline Glick say that a two-state solution is not a viable option.

First, Glick emphasized on “Washington Watch” how Harris’ comments during Tuesday’s debate are likely to “lower her level of support” in Israel. As a senior contributing editor at the Jewish News Syndicate, Glick and her colleagues have been conducting polls “of Israeli sentiments regarding the presidential race.” As she stated, after their most recent update shortly before the presidential debate, “Trump was leading by more than two-thirds of Israelis supporting him over Kamala Harris.” She added, “I assume that next week when we poll that question,” the results will be similar.

Glick further noted that Harris made potentially “the most hostile statement ever made by a major presidential candidate, by a nominee of one of the major parties, regarding Israel in history. ... Her hostility toward Israel was stunning.”

Glick explained how the attack on Oct. 7 was the “most sadistic” slaughter Israel has seen, and yet, Harris’ stance seems to reflect that she sees a cease-fire as a way to “pay the Palestinians.” And while it is true that many Palestinian civilians have died over this past year, Glick asserted that this was still “very much an invasion of Palestinian society into Israel, not just Hamas.”

According to Glick, some military estimates found that out of the 10,000 people that entered Israel from Gaza during the attack, 5,000 to 6,000 were Hamas members, and the rest were Palestinian civilians. And so, Perkins noted, when considering the fact that Harris wants a solution that’s in “equal measure for the Palestinians,” it becomes even clearer how the Biden-Harris administration’s “support of Israel has been tepid at best.” Moving forward, he asked, is it possible policies under a potential Harris-Walz administration would be “even more indifferent toward Israel or outright hostile?”

In response, Glick emphasized how, should Harris get elected, America could expect to see more hostility [toward Israel](#). “I think that what Kamala Harris showed at the debate ... is that an America under her presidency will not allow Israel to do anything beyond intercepting missiles en route to Israel” and will not allow the Jewish state to take “offensive actions against our enemies, whether it’s Iran or the Palestinians or Hezbollah.”

Glick pointed out how Harris said she “will always support Israel’s right to defend itself,” but that doesn’t change the fact that “the United States right now continues to embargo 2,000-pound bunker buster bombs to Israel, because they don’t want us to take offensive action that will effectively diminish the capacities of our enemies.”

Returning to the topic of the two-state solution, Perkins addressed how the land in question includes a “small strip of the [Gaza Strip](#),” the home of the people attacking Israel. Considering this, he asked, how would Israel be able to defend itself if its land “is given away to a hostile entity?”

“It can’t,” Glick said somberly. “It manifestly cannot do so.” Which is “the problem,” she added, because “people talk about the two-state solution as if this is some sort of responsible policy, but it’s not.” Rather, it establishes “a [Palestinian state](#), causing Israel to renounce our rights to our biblical homeland” and paves the way for “Israel to be defeated.”

Glick concluded, “[G]iving people whose goal in life is to annihilate the Jewish state and the Jewish people ... sovereignty over the West Bank of the Jordan of Judea and Samaria” means “giving them the keys to the realm. You are telling them, ‘Go ahead, wipe Israel off the map.’”



## UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY WIDELY SUPPORTS A PALESTINIAN RESOLUTION DEMANDING ISRAEL END ITS OCCUPATION

The U.N. General Assembly strongly supported a nonbinding Palestinian resolution Wednesday demanding that Israel end its “unlawful presence” in Gaza and the occupied West Bank within a year. The vote in the 193-member world body on Wednesday was 124-14, with 43 abstentions

### WORLD’S PATH TO PEACE SHOULD NO LONGER BE BLOCKED BY ONE OR TWO COUNTRIES,

NEW YORK: Decades of debate on reforming the UN Security Council reached what some are calling a turning point this week with the adoption of a “groundbreaking” pact that commits member states to implementing long-demanded changes.

For Tareq AlBanaï, Kuwait’s permanent representative to the UN, the pact was the culmination of two years of work built on the belief that no single member state should be able to obstruct action on a matter of global urgency.

Since 2022, AlBanaï and Austria’s ambassador to the UN have spearheaded the inter-governmental negotiations to reform the Security Council, whose five permanent members have retained their veto power since the UN’s formation in 1945.

AlBanaï described his time co-chairing the inter-governmental negotiations on Security Council reforms as a “labor of love.”

“The Security Council is the only body charged with the maintenance of international peace and security,” he told Arab News. “It is the cornerstone of the multilateral system and the UN when it comes to peace and security. The everyday man around the world — when he thinks of the UN, he thinks of the Security Council.

“And when we see the Security Council unable to act on the most pressing situations around the world that threaten international peace and security, you lose faith in this institution.

“And that is not a good thing. It is the only, truly, universal, multilateral system that we have.”

The mounting calls to reform the council are decades in the making.

Countries such as India, Brazil, Germany and Japan have renewed their appeal for permanent seats to better reflect the geopolitical realities of the 21st century. Meanwhile, the Permanent 5 members (US, UK, France, Russia and China) have urged caution, highlighting the need for “consensus and stability.”

The intergovernmental negotiations led by Kuwait and Austria have included discussions on regional representation, the criteria for new permanent members and the balance of power within the Security Council.

“A reformed Security Council, in my opinion, needs to be a place where we can secure collective action through the collective understanding of the members,” AlBanai said.

“No member state should have the ability to stop the majority of the world from taking decisive action on any matter at hand.

“And if they decide to use a prerogative, then there must be ways that we can, as an international community, through the General Assembly or through any other mechanisms we agree on in the future, find an alternative path.

“The path to peace cannot be (stymied) by one, two or even three member states when the majority of the world believes that the way forward is in a specific manner.”



# WHY SAUDI ARABIA'S FUTURE NOW DEPENDS ON 'ZERO PROBLEMS WITH NEIGHBOURS'

When the Islamist AKP [came to power](#) in [Turkey](#) in 2002, it was determined to turn a new page with Middle Eastern countries with a policy known as “zero problems with neighbours”.

Under Foreign Minister [Ahmet Davutoglu](#)'s guidance, the policy saw an efflorescence of political and economic ties with countries that the Kemalist military had previously kept at arm's length - until it all came crashing down with the [Arab Spring uprisings](#) and Turkey's support for parties to the ensuing conflicts.

During the king's first months in office, western countries signed the [Iran nuclear deal](#) and the Iran-allied [Houthi](#) movement in [Yemen](#) tried to extend their rule down to Aden after seizing power in Sanaa.

Worry about potential domestic opposition was still raw despite the 2013 coup against a Muslim Brotherhood-led government in [Egypt](#).

The new leadership's posture was paranoid and bellicose. A war was [launched in Yemen](#) in an effort to restore the ousted government.

As Houthi drone and missile capabilities improved, enabling them to begin firing at targets inside Saudi Arabia, the kingdom threatened to [sponsor Iranian opposition groups](#) staging attacks inside Iran.

Riyadh launched the [Qatar](#) boycott in an effort to crush Doha's support for Islamists in 2017, and in 2018 orchestrated the murder of regime insider-turned-critic [Jamal Khashoggi](#) in Istanbul.

Regional laughing stock

Yet this hawkish approach came to a sudden halt with [the Aramco attacks](#) in September 2019. Several months before, oil tankers in [UAE](#) waters had [come under attack](#). Now it was Saudi Arabia's turn, with an early morning drone and missile barrage that was precise enough to take out five percent of global oil production for several weeks.

Worse still, the [US](#), Saudi Arabia's decades-long ally, failed to step up, despite President Donald Trump's constant egging on of Bin Salman throughout his administration. Trump released strategic oil reserves to stabilise markets and declared the US military was "[locked and loaded](#)" to respond. But beyond that, no concrete response to Iran's daring move materialised - and the shock to the Saudi leadership was profound.

“Our people will amaze the world again,” the original [Vision 2030](#) document declared, imagining the country as a new Silicon Valley that would drive the global economy of the future.

Or a downtown area of Riyadh called the New Murabba, featuring a cube structure big enough to contain 30 Empire State Buildings. Or the regenerated historical district of Riyadh called Diriyah, or the sports and entertainment city Qiddiya.

The tourism projects extend all the way down the Red Sea coast, including the Red Sea Global resorts near Al-Wajh, the Jeddah Central project and the Ardara development in the mountains of Abha. Some of them, like the “extreme sports”

oil rigs off the Gulf coast near Dammam, called [The Rig](#), seemed downright ridiculous.

Complete about-face

It's no exaggeration to say the Saudi leadership has gambled its future on these monstrous plans. The Public Investment Fund, which owns and manages the projects, has around 168 subsidiaries in total, most of them local, and collectively they have been valued at [over \\$1.25tn](#).

Now the pressure is on to make them a reality after the government won the rights to host the 2029 Asian Winter Games in the Neom mountain resort of Trojena, the 2030 World Expo in Riyadh, and the [2034 football World Cup](#) - which will be the jewel in the crown of Vision 2030.

Already funding problems have kicked in, with global oil prices failing to hit Saudi Arabia's current breakeven price of \$96 per barrel and foreign direct investment far below a targeted \$100bn per year by 2030.

So the last thing the Saudi regime needs is political problems with neighbours, and it's that realisation that has caused a complete about-face on Yemen, Iran and, since the [Gaza war](#) erupted last October, on [Israeli-Palestinian](#) peace too.

Just before a formal ceasefire was agreed with the Houthis in April 2022, the Saudi leadership got a sense of where things were going without drastic action. Houthi missiles and drones struck an Aramco distribution plant in Jeddah, a desalination plant and targeted Riyadh. The Yemen intervention was not only causing global reputational damage and blocking access to US weaponry, it was threatening to cause serious economic harm, too.

Since then Riyadh has been on a crusade to agree peace terms with the Houthis, who are firmly ensconced as the war's victors in Sanaa, and then force its Yemeni allies into their own peace talks with the Iran-backed Zaydi Shia group.

The Houthi attacks [on Red Sea shipping](#) have forced the Saudis to put brakes on the plan for now, but the need for the ceasefire to hold saw Riyadh intervene in July to force its allies in Aden to back down in their campaign to have Sanaa cut off from the global banking system.

All it took for this intervention was a speech from Houthi leader Abdulmalik al-Houthi threatening to restart the attacks if the Saudis didn't step in. In the months before 7 October, a Saudi delegation had visited Sanaa and a Houthi delegation was then received by the defence minister, Bin Salman's kid-brother Khaled, in Riyadh.

### Global shift

This stunning reversal on Yemen after a war that at one point the UN was calling the [worst humanitarian crisis](#) in the world, was underpinned by another volte-face when Saudi Arabia and Iran agreed [to normalise relations](#) in a deal [brokered by China](#) in March 2023.

Since then, what some observers thought would amount to a cold peace has moved at a brisk pace, with ambassadors back in place in each country, agreements to boost bilateral trade and regular consultations over the Gaza crisis.

As for the Qatar boycott, it was formally ended in January 2021 when Gulf leaders, including Qatar's Emir Tamim, [gathered](#) amid a flood of mediated hugs at one of the Saudi mega projects, the Nabataean ruins of AlUla, which have transmogrified into a wellness and adventure tourism resort. Now the government is even enticing Qatari investors to put money into some Vision 2030 projects, especially mining - another field where Saudi Arabia wants to be a global player.

The latest turnaround concerns Israel. Bin Salman has long been seeking a way to normalise ties, mainly for concessions he could extract from the United States in return. It was clear, even during the first months of Israel's Gaza campaign, that his government had little taste for the pro-Palestinian politics of earlier eras.

In the early stages of the war, the subtext to messages blasted daily on social media platform X by his buddy Turki Alalshikh, the head of the General Entertainment Authority, was that nostalgia and emotions must not stop the inevitable march of progress.

Just before 7 October, it looked like Bin Salman was about to get his way. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu was crowing about an imminent "[dramatic breakthrough](#)", in which Saudi Arabia would get a defence pact with the United States in return for peace with Israel. The Palestinian Authority would be offered nothing more than a vague [peace plan](#), which suited the Saudi and Israeli leaders just fine.

That was then. Now the conflict has dragged on far longer than anyone imagined. Israel is apparently on a path to pariah status in some parts of the world. The International Court of Justice has ruled that Israel could be guilty of genocide, and the chief prosecutor of the International Criminal Court is seeking arrest warrants against Israeli leaders for suspected war crimes and crimes against humanity.

The Saudi position has hardened in response to this global shift. The US-Saudi defence pact is still on the agenda but decoupled from the Israeli part because Riyadh [now insists](#) on a Palestinian state.

Politically, it has become tough for Saudi Arabia to allow itself to be painted as selling out a cause Bin Salman previously had little time for - the memories of Anwar Sadat and Yitzhak Rabin casting long shadows.

Many things haven't changed in Saudi Arabia - the domestic repression is worse than ever, not least for expressions of support for Palestine. Tribesmen have been [brutally erased](#) from their lands to make way for outrageous vanities like The Line.

The social reforms have been real, if a little top-down and elitist: women can drive and soccer fans can see idols like Cristiano Ronaldo in the flesh, but it's only the urban affluent with westernised tastes who attend the state-organised music raves and jazz festivals.

Saudi Arabia is still a highly conservative society and pilgrimage accounts for half of rising tourist numbers.

But the foreign policy trajectory under the Salmans has been a roller-coaster ride of radical twists and turns, underpinned by one over-riding regime obsession: the Vision Thing must work.

The Pact for the Future — adopted this week at the 79th session of UN General Assembly after nine months of negotiations — offers a consensus vision for cooperation among countries in tackling challenges ranging from climate and artificial intelligence to escalating conflicts and increasing inequality and poverty.

But, more importantly for those eyeing Security Council reform, the pact also commits world leaders to reform the 15-member organ to better reflect today's

world, “redress the historical injustice against Africa,” which has no permanent seat, and correct the underrepresentation of the Asia-Pacific region and Latin America.

Austria and Kuwait led the negotiations on council reform with vigor, holding a series of televised debates on the topic. Alongside discussions on the main pact, UN members hosted isolated Security Council reform talks, recognizing that the topic could complicate agreements on other issues included in the document.

Guy Ryder, the UN’s under secretary-general for policy, called the language in the pact “groundbreaking,” highlighting the commitment to develop a consolidated model of Security Council reform.

“Now, this might sound rather esoteric, and this would be one of the most difficult things to explain to the person in the street, but for those engaged in this type of process since the 1960s, and the co-facilitators of negotiations, Austria and Kuwait, this is groundbreaking language,” Ryder told Arab News.

AlBanai agreed, highlighting the avenue to substantial reform that the pact has opened.

“Is it groundbreaking? Well, it’s the first time since 1963 that we have a commitment at the head of state and government level to further enhance the Security Council,” he said, calling for a council that is representative, transparent, effective, inclusive, democratic and accountable.

This is essential for the operation of a functioning multilateral system, according to Al-Banai.

“If we can manage through this process to enhance not only the capacity of the Security Council, but the actual shape, form and actions of the council by increasing its membership, by making it more representative of the world we live in today in 2024, and not the world of 1945, then we have achieved something,” he said.

With only the first step on a long journey ahead having been taken, AlBanai is acutely aware that reform has been a painstakingly slow process.

In the months after the UN was founded in 1945, some member states had already recognized the need for a more flexible Security Council. It was only in the late

1970s that some brought the issue of council reform to the attention of the General Assembly.

Yet substantial progress has remained elusive. One of the most significant barriers to reform has been the frequent turnover of diplomats and experts at the UN, which can stifle continuity in discussions.

To address this, AlBanai and his co-chair, Austrian Ambassador Alexander Marshall, prioritized transparency in negotiations.

Through initiatives like webcasting meetings and creating a comprehensive repository of documents, they aimed to make the reform process accessible to a broader audience, including NGOs and academic institutions. That decision has opened the doors for new stakeholders to engage with the reform process, fostering a more inclusive atmosphere for discussion.

One of the most controversial results of the Security Council's existing format has been the increasingly liberal use of veto power by some permanent members.

In recent years, lone members of the P5 have paralyzed and undermined the credibility of the council, in a pattern that risks damaging the reputation of the entire organization, according to representatives from a wide spectrum of countries.

AlBanai highlighted the troubling reality of a single veto-wielding permanent member being able to obstruct action, even when the majority of the council supports a motion.

This gridlock has been most evident in discussions surrounding the war in Gaza, with repeated vetoes preventing meaningful action on a ceasefire and urgent humanitarian issues.

"(The veto's) use or misuse have been a central focus of member states because, unfortunately, one member, or a combination of members, with that ability can stop the movement of the wider international community toward addressing an issue as important as the genocide currently happening in Gaza or any other matter that is under consideration in the Security Council," AlBanai said.

While many member states advocate for the abolition of the veto, such a change is complex, requiring the agreement of the existing veto holders, he added.

“It’s unrealistic to expect that the current P5 will agree to eliminate their own power.”

To sidestep this quandary, discussions have shifted toward giving new permanent members — should they be added — veto power, but the proposal has proved contentious among member states.

Those in opposition argue for the need to reduce veto use entirely, with calls to ban use of the veto power in cases of genocide, crimes against humanity and war crimes.

There remains broad support, however, for expanding council membership, in both permanent and non-permanent categories, and for unrepresented or underrepresented regions and continents, such as Africa and Asia, to have a “meaningful seat” at the table.

One notable development in the reform discussions came in the form of a recent US proposal to add two permanent seats for Africa in the council, though without veto power.

“What I like about the American proposal is that it invites conversation,” said AlBani, highlighting the importance of moving from abstract discussion to concrete action.

As part of their efforts, Kuwait and Austria introduced “model discussions,” which invited member states and country blocs to present their models of a reformed Security Council.

“That allows the opportunity to move from a conceptual kind of conversation into an actual, almost 3D conversation, where member states sit at the podium with the co-chairs and present, and then all other member states are given the opportunity to actually ask questions and to, if you will, poke holes in this model,” said AlBani.

He welcomed the US proposal as a positive step and encouraged other member states to do the same: “The Americans have moved from one African member to now two African members. Maybe they’ll move to two permanent African members with a veto in the future. Who knows? But we have to have that conversation, and we have to inject new blood into it.”

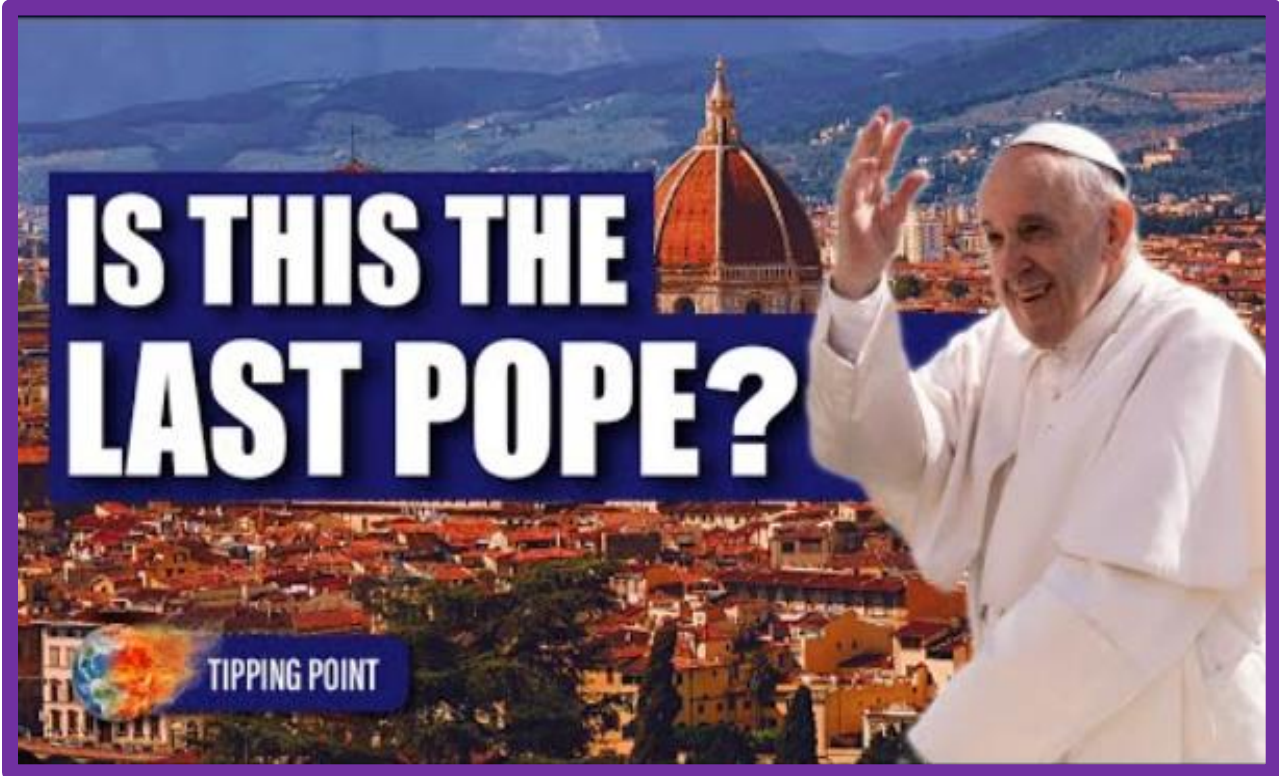
The discussions on UNSC reform have also included a focus on regional representation. One longstanding proposal that has been almost universally accepted is adding a permanent seat for the Arab world, which has long been advocated by the Arab League.

Cross Regional Groups have also introduced the idea of permanent seats for themselves, such as Small Island Developing States, known as SIDS, as well as the Organization of Islamic Cooperation.

“I don’t know what the criteria is. Is it the number of agenda items that are discussed in the Security Council? Is it your population? Is it the fact that you have the biggest army? The biggest economy? Could it be the number of international treaties that you’ve signed? Your compliance with international law? There are so many criteria out there, and the discussions should help us narrow in on who is deserving of this seat and how that could be in the future.

“But, surely, the most important thing is that we have a Security Council that reflects the realities of today.”

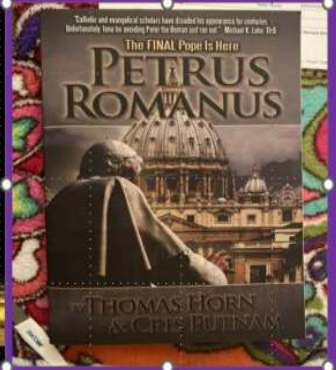
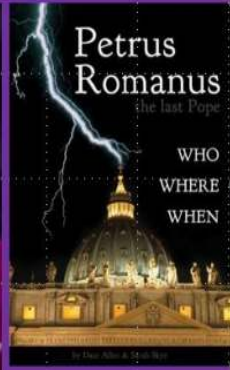
