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POPE FRANCIS CLAIMS CLIMATE CHANGE HAS THE WORLD 'NEAR BREAKING POINT'

Pope Francis has claimed that the climate crisis has the planet "[near breaking point](#)," laying some of the blame on the door of the United States and its populations "irresponsible lifestyle." The Pontiff, who has previously been outspoken on the theme of climate change, made the chilling remark in the introduction to a three-day climate summit to be hosted at the Vatican, which will be held between May 15 and 17.

Francis, a native of Argentina, said he had "heartfelt concerns" for "our suffering planet." Due to a societal reluctance to take adequate steps to protect against climate change, the Catholic figurehead ominously predicted that "the world in which we live is collapsing."

The Pontiff claims that it is "indubitable" that climate change will accelerate inequality and further impoverish some of the world's most vulnerable people. The impact of climate change can already be seen in "healthcare, sources of employment, access to resources, housing, forced migrations, etc," the 87-year-old wrote, reports Breitbart.

Echoing the previous sentiments of the Bishops of the United States, the Pope predicted that climate change "is one of the principal challenges facing society and the global community." Further, these issues are "borne by the most vulnerable people, whether at home or around the world," the head of the Catholic Church said.

Pope Francis highlighted the United States as a country whose culture and the lifestyles of its people are accelerating the rate of climate change. "If we consider that emissions per individual in the United States are about two times greater than those of individuals living in China, and about seven times greater than the average of the poorest countries, we can state that a broad change in the irresponsible lifestyle connected with the Western model would have a significant long-term impact," the Pope wrote in October 2023.

However, The Pillar Catholic, an online Catholic news outlet, disputed the Pope's climate figures. They highlighted that "US per capita emissions are less than 1.5 times that of China." They also referenced that China's latest per capita emission figures "are significantly higher than the global average."

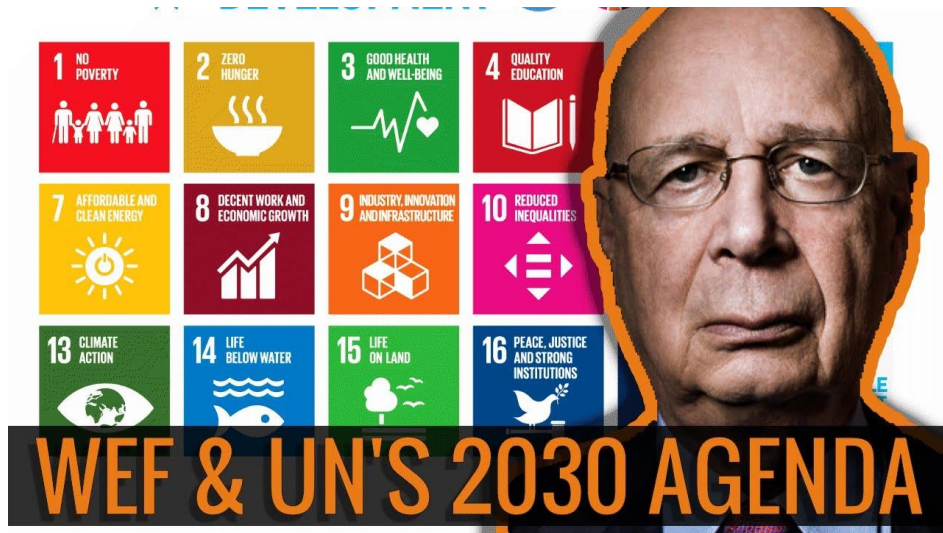
The outlet furthered that, in the aggregate, China's emissions are more than double those of the United States. The air quality in the US is among the cleanest in the world; while China, meanwhile, has among the worst quality of air in the world.

Meanwhile, San Diego Bishop Robert W McElroy, who ascended to the rank of cardinal in 2022, warned that climate change challenged the very future of humanity. He described the climate emergency as "the long-term death toll from unchecked climate change is larger and threatens the very future of humanity."

VISION 2030: GREEN INITIATIVE

Saudi Green Initiative (SGI) is an ambitious national initiative that is focused on combating climate change, improving quality of life, and protecting the environment for future generations. Launched in 2021 by His Royal Highness Prince Mohammed bin Salman bin Abdulaziz, Crown Prince and Prime Minister, [SGI](#) is a whole-of-society initiative, uniting all sustainability efforts in the country to rapidly scale up the Kingdom's climate action. SGI supports Saudi Arabia's ambition to reach net zero emissions by 2060 through the Circular Carbon Economy approach and is also accelerating the country's transition to a green economy. Three overarching targets guide SGI's work - emissions reduction, afforestation, and land and sea protection.

Since SGI's inauguration, 77 initiatives corresponding to the three targets have been activated, representing an investment of more than \$186bn and helping to drive sustainable growth. By bringing together the government and private sector, and fostering collaboration and innovation, the Kingdom's commitments have been turned into tangible action, whilst supporting global goals.

SAUDI ARABIA ALLOCATES \$2.5 BILLION TO MIDDLE EAST GREEN INITIATIVE

Central to Saudi Arabia’s strategy for addressing climate change is the implementation of afforestation programs

Saudi Arabia has made a significant allocation of \$2.5 billion to the Secretariat of the Middle East Green Initiative, which has garnered the attention and participation of numerous countries. ***MORE COUNTRIES HAVE EXPRESSED INTEREST IN JOINING THIS INITIATIVE, MAKING IT THE LARGEST GREEN INITIATIVE GLOBALLY.***

During his participation in a panel discussion titled ***‘SAUDI ARABIA’S EFFORTS IN CLIMATE CHANGE’ DURING THE NATIONAL GREENING FORUM***, Adel bin Ahmed Al-Jubeir, Minister of State for Foreign Affairs, Cabinet Member, and Envoy for Climate Affairs, emphasized Saudi Arabia’s commitment to environmental protection through the fund allocation and several other initiatives.

AFFORESTATION AND CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION

Central to Saudi Arabia’s strategy for addressing climate change is the implementation of afforestation programs. Al-Jubeir emphasized that these efforts are not only crucial for environmental sustainability but also essential for achieving the ***AMBITIOUS GOALS OF THE [SAUDI VISION 2030](#)***. Recognizing the interconnectedness of environmental health and societal well-being, Saudi Arabia prioritizes initiatives that promote clean air and a healthy environment.

“As the world’s largest oil producer, the Kingdom feels a responsibility towards the climate and aims to lead efforts in combating climate change, not only by adhering to international standards but also by shaping them,” Al-Jubeir stated.

SAUDI ARABIA’S ROLE IN CLIMATE ACTION

Al-Jubeir underscored Saudi Arabia’s recognition of its interconnectedness with the international community. Moreover, he emphasized that global events profoundly impact the Kingdom and vice versa. By leading efforts to combat climate change through initiatives like the **MIDDLE EAST GREEN INITIATIVE, SAUDI ARABIA AIMS NOT ONLY TO ADHERE TO INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS BUT ALSO TO SHAPE THEM**, leveraging its position as the world’s largest oil producer to drive meaningful change on the global stage.

ECONOMIC IMPLICATIONS

Highlighting the direct economic impact of climate change, Al-Jubeir emphasized the importance of mitigating environmental risks to ensure stability and prosperity. Disasters and floods resulting from climate change disrupt supply chains, shipping and transportation, ultimately affecting consumers and leading to higher commodity prices. Addressing climate change is thus not only an environmental imperative but also an economic necessity for sustainable development.

Middle East Green Initiative

Al-Jubeir concluded by reaffirming Saudi Arabia’s commitment to environmental leadership **THROUGH INITIATIVES SUCH AS THE SAUDI AND MIDDLE EAST GREEN INITIATIVES. LAUNCHED BY H.R.H CROWN PRINCE**, these initiatives aim to harness the Kingdom’s expertise in circular carbon economy, combating desertification, and land rehabilitation. By promoting tree planting and reducing carbon emissions, Saudi Arabia seeks to lead the region towards a sustainable and resilient future.

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SAUDI ARABIA'S TRANSFORMATION FROM OIL TO GREEN ENERGY

Saudi Arabia, a country historically synonymous with oil production, is making strides toward sustainability. Once reliant solely on its vast oil reserves, it is now embracing a green energy revolution that promises to reshape its economic landscape while safeguarding its environmental future.

According to data released by the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Saudi Arabia experienced a staggering 219 percent year-on-year increase in renewable energy capacity in 2023. This surge, reaching 2689 MW, outpaced its regional counterparts.

Propelled by its **AMBITIOUS VISION 2030**, the Kingdom aims to increase its use of non-oil fuels to meet its growing power demand and diversify its energy mix. **THE SAUDI VISION 2030**, launched in 2016, set an initial goal of deploying 9.5GW of green energy by 2030. However, the target has been revised multiple times, with the latest update in 2023 setting a new goal of 130GW of renewable power capacity by 2030. With stronger policies, competitive auctions and financial measures, experts believe the desert country can achieve its renewable energy target.

A recent report published by GlobalData, a data analytics and consulting company, showed that renewable power projects under construction in Saudi Arabia surpassed 8GW by the end of 2023. This is primarily attributed to projects awarded through auctions in the past 18 months. There are also plans for an additional 13GW of renewable power capacity in various stages of development.

The early months of 2024 have been equally promising with ACWA Power securing \$2.3 billion in funding for 4.55GW of large-scale solar parks in Saudi Arabia.

The financing will go for the Ar Raas 2, Saad 2 and Al Kahfah solar photovoltaic projects, which will be located in the central and northern regions of the Kingdom.

ACWA Power, which owns a 50.1 percent stake in each of the three projects, secured a credit facility from a consortium of local, regional and international banks, including Saudi Awwal Bank, Banque Saudi Fransi, HSBC and Standard Chartered Bank.

SAUDI ARABIA'S RENEWABLE ENERGY POTENTIAL

"The major driver for renewable energy in Saudi Arabia is economic," energy policy consultant Jessica Obeid told Al Arabiya English. "By reducing domestic demand for fossil fuels, the Kingdom can free up barrels for export, bolstering its economic resilience."

"As natural gas surpasses oil as the dominant source of power generation in Saudi Arabia, there is a pressing incentive to curtail domestic demand," she added, highlighting the economic rationale underpinning the Kingdom's renewable energy drive.

Beyond economic considerations, the country benefits from several key enablers for the establishment of mega renewable energy plants.

“Factors include the financial capacity to develop bankable projects, abundant renewable resources—particularly solar and wind—and vast expanses of land ripe for development,” Obeid noted.

Moreover, being one of the world's largest producers of hydrocarbons, Saudi Arabia is poised to become a leader in low-carbon technologies, according to Obeid.

“As global pressure mounts to reduce emissions, investments in cleaner energy and low-carbon technologies—such as hydrogen and carbon capture and storage—are set to soar,” she said.

The integration of renewable energy, however, presents unique challenges, requiring flexibility systems, storage solutions, and grid upgrades and infrastructure.

“I expect the focus on these aspects to intensify in the near future,” Obeid remarked, “especially with the proliferation of variable renewable energy sources like wind and solar.”

She also highlighted the potential of geothermal energy to optimize renewables integration into the grid.

“With its ability to meet baseload demand, geothermal power could play a pivotal role in ensuring a seamless transition to a renewable-powered future,” she suggested.

Saudi Arabia boasts extensive geothermal energy reservoirs, particularly along the Red Sea, owing to substantial heat flow from deep within the Earth's crust. Geothermal energy offers a sustainable source of baseload power, suitable for a variety of applications including district heating/cooling, water desalination and electricity generation.

ECONOMIC IMPACT OF CLEAN ENERGY INVESTMENTS

Global shifts toward sustainability have prompted nations worldwide to prioritize investments in clean and renewable energy. In the Middle East, the range and speed of renewable projects serve as encouraging signals within the region and for its global partners in both the public and private spheres. The transition toward clean energy represents a pathway to economic diversification and growth, particularly significant for countries seeking to reduce their reliance on traditional hydrocarbon industries.

Over the next five years, the MENA region aims to incorporate an additional 62GW of renewable energy capacity, as stated by the International Energy Agency (IEA), in alignment with the commitment made at COP28. The rate of expansion is projected to escalate, exceeding threefold compared to the preceding five-year span, with solar capacity contributing to over 85 percent of the increase.

In line with this trajectory, Saudi Arabia has emerged as a notable participant, strategically investing in clean energy efforts to drive economic diversification. Analysts believe that these investments carry major economic implications, driving prosperity within the Kingdom's economy.

“Firstly, from a foundational economic standpoint, the projects in question represent value-added, productive endeavors of strategic importance. They not only stimulate economic activity but also address the pressing need for economic and energy diversification, catalyzing job and output growth while likely yielding attractive returns for investors,” Adel Afiouni, senior investment banking and institutional finance executive and Lebanon’s former minister of state for investments and technology, told Al Arabiya English.

“Secondly, from an impact perspective, **THE INITIATIVES FIRMLY POSITION SAUDI ARABIA AS A PIONEER IN CLEAN ENERGY, CLIMATE TECHNOLOGY, AND INNOVATION.** Recognizing the global momentum towards stronger climate regulations, particularly from authorities, regulators, and governments, these sectors are poised for exponential growth in the coming decades,” Afiouni said. “As worldwide compliance requirements drive the emergence of new business opportunities in climate and sustainability, **THE KINGDOM STANDS TO REAP SIGNIFICANT BENEFITS BY LEADING IN INNOVATION AND DRIVING FORWARD THIS TRANSFORMATIVE AGENDA.**”

Afiouni mentioned that the development of renewable energy, clean technology, and climate projects generates surplus carbon credits at both the national and project levels.

“These credits serve to offset carbon emissions produced by other industries, a critical step in prioritizing carbon emission reduction,” he noted. “This not only enhances economic competitiveness but also reduces funding costs and enhances export sales profitability, thereby fostering a more sustainable economic environment.”

He added: “The ongoing revolution in climate technology compliance and regulations is poised to permeate every aspect of the economy. Recognizing this, Saudi Arabia and the rest of the GCC are proactively identifying and implementing strategic measures to adapt to and capitalize on these changes.”

To facilitate the transition, Saudi Arabia recently introduced its green financing framework, designed to raise money for environmentally-friendly projects and steer away from fossil fuels. The framework paves the way for the issuance of green bonds and sukuk, which will channel funds toward sustainable initiatives. Any sale of such debt would be a first for the central government as it aims to cut its greenhouse gas emissions by 278 million tons per year by 2030 and have net zero emissions by 2060.

“This progressive framework empowers companies and governments to access an expanding pool of green capital, thereby diversifying funding sources and attracting investments at more

favorable costs,” Afiouni emphasized. “Given the magnitude of projects underway in Saudi Arabia and the **AMBITIOUS ROADMAP SET BY VISION 2030**, there is a necessity to develop financing instruments beyond traditional channels. Thus, the development of diverse, efficient, and liquid capital markets becomes a paramount priority in maximizing foreign direct investments and funding transformative ventures.”



FIRST NATIONAL GREENING FORUM HELD IN RIYADH

RIYADH: As countries around the world push to invest in nature-based solutions to environmental problems, experts in Saudi Arabia came together in Riyadh to discuss the most pressing issues at the inaugural National Greening Forum.

Launched under the patronage of Minister of Environment, Water and Agriculture Abdulrahman Al-Fadhli, the forum was organized by the National Center for Vegetation Cover Development and Combating Desertification and attended by Minister of Municipal, Rural Affairs and Housing Majed Al-Hogail, several other ministers, organisations and specialists from local, regional and international sectors related to the environment.

CEO of the center, Khalid Al-Abdulqader, said in his opening speech that the forum will “unify and consolidate national efforts to enhance vegetation cover and mitigate land degradation.”

Addressing the restoration of green spaces in the Kingdom, he said: “We are committed to restoring natural green spaces using sustainable irrigation methods, planting local tree species, and ensuring their protection and monitoring through advanced technologies.”

In a panel discussion titled “Nature-Based Solutions: Key to Transformation,” industry specialists and experts discussed various issues related to promoting the natural growth of trees and their environmental effect, as well as the industries tied to environmental issues and ways their institutions work to find sustainable solutions for the future.

“Vegetation and afforestation are part of nature, which includes the atmosphere, soil, and organisms. The correlation between all of these is the main element for these solutions. So, organizing and monitoring this relationship is key for sustainability and greening,” said Dr. Ahmed Al-Farhan, board member of the center and a faculty member at King Saud University.

For ages, large plumes of dust and sand sweeping across most of Saudi Arabia were a natural, seasonal occurrence, but this year there has been an unusual and noticeable decrease in sandstorms.

Jamaan Al-Qahtani, executive director of the Regional Center for Dust and Sandstorms, explained: “Sandstorms need two factors to occur: dry, load-bearing soil and winds fast enough to carry it.” A few years ago, he said, there were indications that the Kingdom was experiencing fewer sandstorms.

“This April was a 60 percent drop on the average of the past 20 years. March was 30 percent, and January was more than 60 percent. Last year, Riyadh had a record of only one sandstorm.”

Explaining the reason behind this, he said: “We attribute that firstly to rainfall and the timing of that rainfall. When rain falls during the best time for vegetation, that helps with stabilizing the soil.”

The environmental system also plays a pivotal role in preventing degradation, as well as laws that restrain individuals and other entities from tampering with the environment.

Sand and dust storms affect 11 of the UN’s 17 sustainable development goals. For example, 7 million people in total die from all sources of air pollution and degraded air quality. The Middle East and North Africa region loses \$150 billion annually due to weather and climate disasters, Al-Qahtani said.

To meet the growing demand for fresh water in Saudi Arabia, authorities launched a project in 2022 that alters the structure of clouds to increase rainfall; a technique known as cloud seeding.

Ayman Al-Bar, executive director of the Regional Cloud Seeding Program, said “environmental phenomena have become much more severe and common than before.” He went on to say that one of the initiatives under the Middle East Green Initiative, the cloud seeding program, targets an increase in rainfall of between 10% and 20%.

The various initiatives under the program work to intensify vegetation cover, combat desertification, localize technology, and transfer knowledge, he said. In the fifth stage, which covers Riyadh, Hail, and southern parts such as Abha, Taif, and Asir, 1,530 flight hours were spent on precipitation efforts and 110 hours on research. “Preliminary reports indicate that precipitation exceeds 4 billion cubic meters of rainfall in the targeted area,” Al-Bar said.

Dr. Talal Al-Harigi, CEO of Imam Abdulaziz Royal Nature Reserve, said: “When it comes to carbon sequestration, which is capturing carbon through natural solutions, trees naturally grow by taking in carbon dioxide. When some soil patches deteriorate, we’ve undergone processes for soil rehabilitation and preparing them to receive rain either from rainfall or other sources.”

Nature reserves are a prime example of nature-based solutions, Al-Harigi said. Within the Imam Abdulaziz Royal Nature Reserve, the King Khalid Royal Reserve, and others, authorities found that vegetation cover was refreshed and that there was greater soil stability, as well as improved soil fertility.

Ultimately, most industries are affected by environmental deterioration and climate change, and while natural disasters are expected to increase and worsen, Saudi Arabia has taken a leading role in creating sustainable solutions for generations to come.

The forum highlighted the role of public, private and nonprofit sectors in achieving the Saudi Green Initiative target of planting 10 billion trees and providing a platform to participating organisations to engage and exchange knowledge.



He won a Nobel Prize. Then he started denying climate change.

John Clauser shared the Nobel in physics last year. Now he's a self-described 'denier' of the overwhelming scientific consensus on a warming planet.

John Clauser is a world-renowned physicist known chiefly for his contributions in the realm of quantum mechanics. Clauser holds degrees from prestigious research universities like Columbia University, Cal-Tech and Baltimore Polytechnic Institute. His qualifications for expertise in the scientific field are impeccable and barely rivaled among his peers.

Indeed, until this year, Clauser was so universally respected that he won the Nobel Prize in physics in 2022. In 2010, he was also awarded the equally prestigious Wolf Prize in physics, awarded each year by the Wolf Foundation in Israel.

But Clauser now finds himself under assault by many of his government grant-funded peers and our worthless propaganda media establishment because of his decision to tell the truth about the so-called "climate crisis," i.e., that there is no such thing as a climate crisis at all.



NOBEL PRIZE WINNER CANCELED BY THE IMF AFTER QUESTIONING CLIMATE CHANGE DATA



John Clauser, a Nobel prize-winning physicist, is apparently the latest target of a cancel campaign. [According](#) to a group called the Co2 Coalition, Clauser was scheduled to speak to a group at the International Monetary Fund on climate change when critics spotted a serious problem: he does not support the accepted view on the subject. The response was all-too-familiar (even if less expected by Nobel laureates): Clauser had to be barred from sharing his scientific views or being heard by others at the IMF.

During the pandemic, dissenting scientists were regularly banned or canceled for questioning the efficacy of masks, suggesting a lab theory on the origins of Covid, raising natural immunity defenses, and other viewpoints. They have been largely vindicated. Yet, censorship remains commonplace even at universities and organizations like the IMF.

Clauser was reportedly guilty of questioning the reliability of the predictions of the United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change. So an organization of economists based on objective data and research decided to bar others from hearing countervailing views.

Clauser reportedly received an email from the Director of the Independent Evaluation Office of the [International Monetary Fund, Pablo Moreno](#), who had seen a flyer for the zoom talk. It was immediately postponed. The natural default at the IMF and other organizations was to stop speech as potentially harmful when it does not comport with official viewpoints. It appears that Moreno and the IMF could not even tolerate a simple Zoom discussion that offered an alternative viewpoint.

Clauser has earned the ire of climate change advocates by calling the underlying scientific claims “dangerous misinformation” based on shoddy research. I can certainly see why that is not welcomed. However, rather than simply refute his views with their own data, these groups want to prevent others from hearing him.

The IMF has said little in the aftermath of the indefinite postponement. Why should it? The silence is precisely what it sought to achieve.

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**‘KINGDOM AIMS TO LEAD IN GLOBAL EFFORTS TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE,’
SAYS SAUDI’S CLIMATE ENVOY**

RIYADH: ***THE INAUGURAL NATIONAL GREENING FORUM***, which was organized by the National Center for Vegetation Cover Development & Combating Desertification, took place in Riyadh on Monday to look at the Kingdom’s efforts in afforestation and combating climate change.

Adel Al-Jubeir, the Kingdom’s climate envoy and Saudi minister of state for foreign affairs, took to the stage to speak of cementing the country’s role within the global community.

He said: “Climate and afforestation are part of the Kingdom’s policy regarding dealing with climate change and the environment.

“This is a ***BIG PART OF VISION 2030*** in terms of quality of life. The Kingdom is part of the international community. Anything that happens globally affects the Kingdom, and vice versa.

“Having clean air and a healthy environment matters to that community, and afforestation is part of facing climate change.”

The minister added that drought had historically caused conflicts, population displacement, and health issues which had made land rehabilitation crucial not only for the environment but also for global stability, security, and quality of life.

Al-Jubeir said: “As the largest exporter of oil globally, the Kingdom feels a responsibility towards the climate, and ***ITS GOAL IS TO BECOME THE LEADING NATION IN THIS SECTOR, AND NOT A COUNTRY WHICH FOLLOWS GLOBAL STANDARDS. WE NEED TO SET THESE STANDARDS.***”

The envoy recently attended the ***WORLD ECONOMIC FORUM SPECIAL MEETING, HOSTED FOR THE FIRST TIME BY THE KINGDOM IN RIYADH, WHICH DISCUSSED OPPORTUNITIES FOR GLOBAL COLLABORATION AND GROWTH. HE SAID THAT THE KINGDOM’S PARTICIPATION WAS A CLEAR SIGN OF ITS PIVOTAL ROLE IN CONFRONTING INTERNATIONAL CHALLENGES.***

He added: “Climate is related to multiple sectors, including the economy. Floods and natural disasters cause a rise in the price of goods, impact machinery and delivery trucks, which also alters delivery periods and costs, and also impacts the consumer. These things are directly correlated to our everyday lives, not just locally but globally.”

He said that nature-based solutions were pivotal points of discussion at global platforms like the World Economic Forum, adding that the world needs further collaboration to combat such issues sustainably.

He said: “I think there must be conviction with this challenge. There are differences in how to reach the desired goal between developed and developing countries, but I do not think that there is any country that opposes reaching this goal.”

The Kingdom believes the issue should be dealt with comprehensively and logically, taking into consideration such factors as afforestation, minimizing consumption, technological development, carbon capture methods, rehabilitation, and establishing nature reserves.

Al-Jubeir said: “For example, European countries are concentrating on hydrocarbons, petrol, and gas, but they forget animals, industry, cement, and chemicals.”

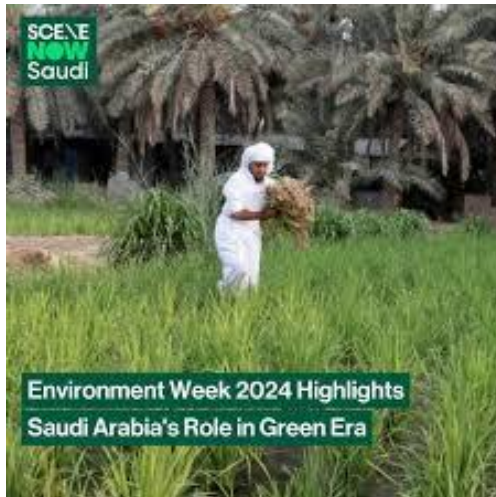

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ENVIRONMENT WEEK EVENTS PUT SAUDI ARABIA'S LEADERSHIP ROLE IN THE LIMELIGHT



RIYADH: The region of Middle East and North Africa is known for its hot, dry climate and scarce water resources. The harsh climatic conditions are a contributing factor to the region's perennial scourge of drought, desertification and land degradation.

These challenges result in imbalances in different ecosystems, harming especially the agriculture sector and imposing economic hardship on local populations. The growing importance of this regional issue has been a motivating factor for Saudi Arabia to host regular discussions.

This week, **ENVIRONMENT WEEK**, has been an opportunity to take stock of the challenges ahead and the progress made so far. Events organized during Environment Week highlighted **SAUDI ARABIA'S LEADERSHIP ROLE IN ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVATION AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT**.

Environmentalists were given a forum to exchange on a range of subjects, with the emphasis naturally on drought, desertification and land degradation. For this occasion, Arab News interviewed Ibrahim Thiaw, executive secretary of the **UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION TO COMBAT DESERTIFICATION IN RIYADH**.

"It has become extremely difficult for humanity to cope with the frequency of challenges," he said. "Saudi Arabia is playing a very important role of course. It is not a small economy, therefore the demand for support from Saudi Arabia is also growing."

Thiaw spoke of some of the outcomes of land degradation and drought such as the increase of irregular migration due to land degradation and drought. "You will likely see more competition of land and water, and therefore, more conflict," he said.

Drought, a major problem in many Middle East countries, has put water resources under stress in tandem with rising temperatures. Both surface water and groundwater reserves are failing owing to declining precipitation and rising evaporation rates.

As a result, rivers and lakes are drying up and water shortages have become a serious problem. Moreover, because of multiple environmental reasons, including drought, the region has been experiencing frequent sandstorms.

“There are around 50 countries that are sources of dust storms, but there are 150 countries that are affected by this phenomenon. Therefore, it has become a global issue,” Thiaw said, speaking about the impact of dust storms in one nation on another.

“You may use one country to shine a spotlight on dust storms, but these constitute a global phenomenon that we all need to address. To do that, you need global treaties like the UN Convention to Combat Desertification, which at the moment has 197 parties. So, it is a universal body and has a summit, a meeting every two years.

“THE NEXT MEETING WILL BE HELD HERE IN RIYADH IN DECEMBER 2024, WHERE THE 197 COUNTRIES WILL COME TOGETHER AT THE LEVEL OF HEADS OF STATE, AT THE LEVEL OF MINISTERS AND THE LEVEL OF EXPERTS, COMMUNITIES AND NGOS AND CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, to discuss just that, namely the consequences of land degradation and drought on the lives and livelihoods of communities.”

Furthermore, experts point out that drought and desertification influence each other. Desertification, the process by which fertile land transforms into arid desert, is another significant challenge confronting countries of the Middle East and North Africa. Unsustainable agricultural practices, overgrazing, deforestation and soil erosion all contribute to the problem.



Consequently, arable land is lost and food production decreases, exacerbating the problem of food insecurity. Desertification also leads to the displacement of communities, according to Thaiaw, as people are forced to migrate in search of more habitable areas.

Speaking to Arab News on the occasion of Environment Week in Riyadh, Elizabeth Mrema, deputy executive director of the United Nations Environment Program, offered her views on the crisis of desertification.

“As far as Saudi Arabia is concerned, the country has clearly seen its impact and treated it as a priority for this year. I am saying ‘this year’ because at the UN Environmental Assembly at the end of February, Saudi Arabia took the lead on an initiative to combat degradation. It went through and was adopted, and that was on a global level,” said Mrema.

“Beyond that, ***THIS COUNTRY NEXT MONTH, ON JUNE 5, WILL HOST WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY. THIS DAY IS CELEBRATED EVERY YEAR. IT IS GLOBAL BECAUSE IT WAS ADOPTED BY THE UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY. THIS YEAR, IT IS BEING HOSTED BY SAUDI ARABIA.***

“THIS YEAR SAUDI ARABIA WILL HOST THE UN CONFERENCE TO COMBAT DESERTIFICATION. IT WILL BE HOSTED HERE WITH THE THEME ‘OUR LAND, OUR FUTURE’ AGAIN, LAND IS THE FOCUS.”

Additionally, the combination of drought and desertification in one area leads to land degradation, further compounding the Middle East’s environmental crisis. Soil erosion, salinization, and depletion of soil nutrients are some of the results of land degradation.

As agricultural productivity declines worldwide, farmers face key challenges in securing their



livelihoods, in addition to the fact that the environmental problems heighten ecosystem vulnerability, which also leads to biodiversity loss and ecosystem imbalance.

“Saudi Arabia is showing the world that this is a global issue. The initiatives which have been taken by the government in recent years demonstrate the commitment in dealing with these issues,” said Mrema.

“I look at the ***SAUDI VISION 2030***, I look at the environmental strategies of 2018, I look at the ***SAUDI GREEN INITIATIVE***. I look at the ***MIDDLE EAST GREEN INITIATIVE*** with a commitment to reach a regional level to plant 50 billion trees, 10 of which Saudi Arabia has committed to plant in this country. And not in committed in words, but put an institution to lead the road, to make sure that this is happening.”

Addressing the three challenges of drought, desertification and land degradation in the Middle East requires a multifaceted approach. Thiaw and Mrema were of the view that governments, international organizations and local communities need to work together to implement sustainable water management strategies, promote efficient irrigation technologies and invest in renewable energy sources.

Additionally, they said, reforestation efforts and the protection of natural habitats can help reduce desertification and land degradation.

Raising awareness about the importance of sustainable land use practices and supporting affected communities is an important step toward long-term solutions for both the Middle East and North Africa region and the world.

To sum up, countries of the Middle East and North Africa are suffering from effects of intensifying drought, desertification and land degradation. Urgent action is required to reverse this trend and ensure regional environmental sustainability.

By adopting sustainable methods, investing in water management, and promoting conservation actions, communities of the region will be able to reduce the severity of these challenges and assure themselves of a more resilient future.

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NEW SURVEY SUGGESTS THAT THE CLIMATE CHANGE SCAM IS BECOMING A JOKE

VANCOUVER, British Columbia — Do you suffer from climate anxiety? A new survey suggests that you might find yourself increasingly alone. Apparently, the constant fear-mongering isn't working too well anymore.

When 2,230 American adults last month were given a list of issues and asked to judge their importance, "climate change" scored near the bottom, with only 45 percent considering it "very important", alongside "issues of race and diversity" at 40 percent.

Compare that with the list-toppers: the economy (82 percent), inflation (79 percent), and crime (65 percent), according to the [CBS News poll](#) conducted last month by YouGov. When real problems arise, fake ones tend to fade.

[CBS News](#) has pointed out that a "big majority of Americans support U.S. taking steps to reduce climate change," but their survey suggests that respondents had much more pressing priorities. And nowhere is there any mention of what exactly people especially want the government to do about the climate. Not like anyone, anywhere really knows. Which is why, when the countries of the world came together to define an objective, the best they could come up with was to not surpass an overall global temperature of [1.5 degrees Celsius](#) above pre-industrial levels from the year 1900. Since that limit was already surpassed, despite constant harassment and taxation of their citizens under the climate change pretext, they clearly have no idea what they're doing. Their argument is that they just haven't governed hard enough yet or taken enough of your money. How convenient.

Voters told YouGov that they didn't see any difference between the climate change policies of Joe Biden and Donald Trump, and more than half of them said that regardless of whether Biden or Trump is re-elected in November, the winner's policies won't make any difference at all on climate change.

When specifically asked about which of Biden's environment-related policies they support, the only ones considered favorable involved tax rebates — because who's going to say no to the government taking less of your money — and also “more regulations to reduce toxic chemicals in drinking water.” A whopping 70 percent of people voted for that one. Poisoning prevention was the most popular policy initiative of the whole survey — a measure that has nothing at all to do with climate change. But concrete environmental policies with measurable results are no fun for governments because they involve the risk of accountability.

There are worse things than uselessness, though. For instance, there could be a federal carbon tax, like Canada's Liberal Party Prime Minister Justin Trudeau foisted upon Canadians, and which has contributed to massive inflation as the tax is factored into every part of the supply chain. The European Union has a similar tax, but the elites in charge are messing everything up right now at such a breakneck pace, including imposing sanctions that effectively cut themselves off from their own cheap Russian gas supply — that it's hard for Europeans to pinpoint specifically which of the many policy errors is actually responsible for anything anymore.

The US government, by contrast, seems to be in on the joke and isn't overly keen on driving its own economy to ruin over climate change. Quite the opposite, in fact. The U.S., apparently, sees a whole world rife with suckers. Biden's Inflation Reduction Act was presented as a climate initiative, but it really just serves to lure foreign “green” companies to the U.S. The U.S. doesn't have a carbon tax, but rather just [tax credits for companies](#) that “capture” or “sequester” the carbon. European farmers, specifically the Dutch who've been strong-armed into selling off their farmlands to comply with European climate change law, would have loved the option of just being able to submit paperwork claiming the capture and safe disposal of cow farts and defecation.

Judging by the YouGov poll, much of the American public is getting wise to climate change nonsense, as well, which is rather remarkable considering the incessant global propaganda.

“Eco-anxiety” is real, according to the American Psychological Association. Defined as “chronic fear of environmental doom,” it's a wonder that the affliction hasn't been included on the disabilities disclosure list for job applications. The fear can come from direct experience of “extreme weather events”, according to the [Mental Health Commission of Canada](#)— a country whose extreme weather events were previously just considered an integral part of its national identity.

“Exposure to climate change information through news media” can also apparently cause eco-anxiety. No kidding.

Climate change propaganda is just like one big advertisement for self-indulgence. And thanks to western governments' own actions, that's now become something that most can no longer afford.



SAYING THE STAKES COULD NOT BE HIGHER, NEWSOM TO SPEAK AT VATICAN CLIMATE SUMMIT

Gov. Gavin Newsom is taking his climate change advocacy overseas next month to the epicenter of Catholicism, where he was invited to speak at a summit of mayors and governors ***HOSTED BY POPE FRANCIS AT THE VATICAN.***

State and local leaders will gather at the summit from May 15 to 17 to discuss the effects of rising temperatures in their communities, with the goal of broadening the conversation from combating climate change to include strategies to adapt to the reality of a warming planet.

Newsom, who aides said will talk about the impact of fire, flood and drought on California, is expected to be one of a few speakers to address the pope and more than two dozen leaders from around the world.

"This year holds unprecedented significance for democracy and the climate, two intertwined issues which will define our future," Newsom said. "With half the world's population poised to elect their leaders amidst a backdrop of escalating political extremism, and global temperatures hurtling towards alarming new heights, the stakes could not be higher. **THERE IS NO GREATER AUTHORITY THAN MORAL AUTHORITY — AND THE POPE'S LEADERSHIP ON THE CLIMATE CRISIS INSPIRES US ALL TO PUSH FURTHER AND FASTER.**"

FRANCIS IS THE FIRST POPE TO MAKE CLIMATE CHANGE A TOP PRIORITY OF HIS PAPACY, seeking to [marry scientific facts about greenhouse gas emissions with a moral call](#) to the 1.3 billion Catholics worldwide and leaders across the globe to protect the planet for future generations. Critical of the lack of urgent action, the Pope called climate deniers "foolish" in [his first interview on U.S. television last week](#).

For Newsom, a Catholic, the invitation from the Vatican provides an opportunity to show that he's aligned with Francis and appeal to the 50 million Americans who follow the religion. The trip also gives the Democratic governor an international stage to stress the importance of 2024 elections — and the choice between President Biden and former President Trump — on the climate crisis.

BIDEN IS CONSIDERED A FRIEND OF THE CLIMATE MOVEMENT and his Inflation Reduction Act, a 2022 law to increase renewable energy production and decrease greenhouse gas emissions, is one of the nation's largest climate investments. **THE PRESIDENT HAS SOUGHT TO REDUCE THE COUNTRY'S RELIANCE ON COAL AND GAS PLANTS**, which Trump has said he would reverse.

Former Gov. Jerry Brown used his visit to the Vatican in 2017 to deliver a scathing critique of Trump's climate policies. The visit came months after [Trump withdrew from the Paris climate accord](#).

Lauren Sanchez, Newsom's climate advisor, also pointed to elections in India, Mexico and other nations as critical to climate change efforts this year.

Veerabhadran Ramanathan, a professor at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography at UC San Diego, serves in Pope Francis' [Council for the Pontifical Academy of Sciences](#) and helped organize the event. He said invitations were limited to international mayors and governors, including Govs. Maura Healey of Massachusetts and Kathy Hochul of New York. President Biden and other world leaders were not invited to attend, but representatives of his administration will be present, Ramanathan said.

Ramanathan said pressure is on international heads of state to cut emissions, but adaptation starts "bottom up."

"The key thing is to ask yourself, if there's drought, and then there's a fire in our backyard, who is fighting it?" Ramanathan said. "Not presidents of the nation. It's the mayors and governors. **WE WANT TO GIVE THEM SORT OF A BLUEPRINT OF HOW TO DEAL WITH IT.**"

Ramanathan said California is a leader on climate change and the council felt it was important to hear from the state at the summit.

Newsom is expected to repeat the message that the "[climate crisis is a fossil-fuels crisis](#)" and call out the role of oil companies.

"We think the governor stands alone among elected officials around the world who are really willing to say that ***THIS CRISIS IS CREATED BY THE BURNING OF COAL AND OIL AND GAS, AND THAT WE NEED TO MOVE AWAY FROM THOSE FOSSIL FUELS AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE,***" Sanchez said.

In honor of Earth Week, Newsom announced a plan last week to transform more than half of the state's 100 million acres of land into [multi-benefit landscapes that absorb more carbon than they release](#). The plan is part of Newsom's strategy to curtail emissions and [reach carbon neutrality in California by 2045](#). The challenge includes other ambitious targets, such as requiring [all new vehicles sold in California to be hybrid or electric by 2035](#).

Newsom's visit to the Vatican is expected to be brief, with the governor touching down Wednesday, speaking at the conference the following day and wrapping up his engagements on Friday. His delegation includes a few members of his staff. Wade Crowfoot, California's natural resources secretary, is also expected to speak.

Newsom's travels have drawn criticism from his GOP critics, who contend he should be focusing exclusively on problems in California such as the [state's massive budget deficit](#).

The governor went to [China in October to promote climate cooperation](#) with a short stop in Israel in the early stages of the war with Hamas. He left the state again the following month to debate Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis in Georgia and has campaigned in other states in support of Biden's bid for reelection.

The announcement was made at the opening of **SAUDI ARABIA'S ENVIRONMENT WEEK** on Sunday, the Saudi Press Agency reported.

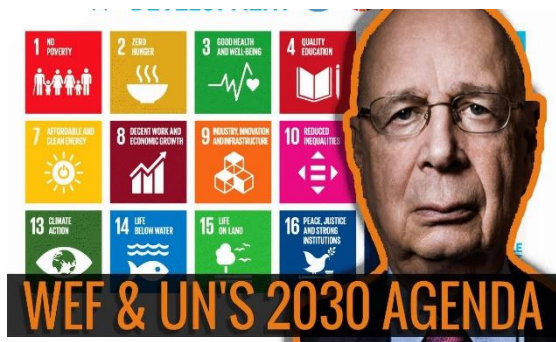

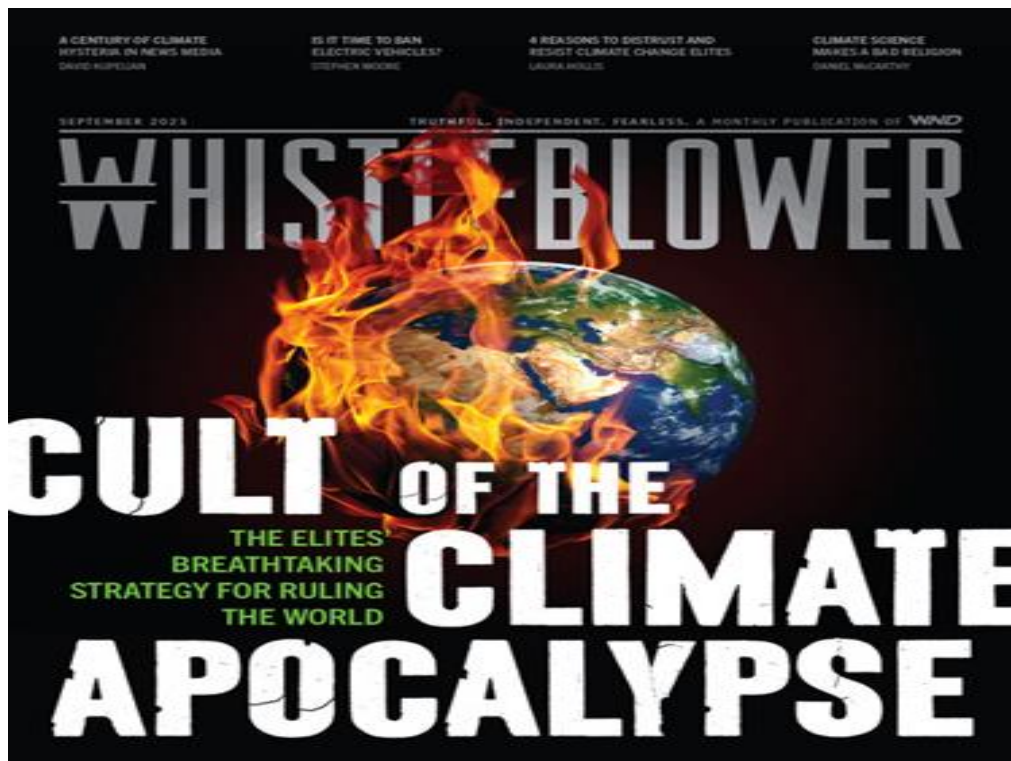

CULT OF THE CLIMATE APOCALYPSE: THE ELITES' BREATHTAKING STRATEGY FOR RULING THE WORLD

And even if fossil fuel elimination policies aren't fully implemented," he adds, "... even widespread restrictions on fossil fuel use that fall far short of elimination will shorten and inflict misery on billions of lives, especially in the poorest parts of the world."

Epstein, founder of the Center for Industrial Progress, doesn't claim fossil fuels and CO2 emissions don't impact climate in any way. "I totally acknowledge," he writes, "that they have contributed to the 1-degree Celsius warming we've experienced over the last one-hundred-plus years."

Question: When the scientific case for catastrophic global warming and its resulting global apocalypse consists largely of a 1-degree rise in temperature over more than 130 years – in a world where global temperatures are widely acknowledged to have risen and fallen spontaneously over the ages – why are all the governments of the Western world obsessed with catastrophic climate change as their unifying principle of governing, public policy and virtually all of life?

Before addressing the astonishing truth underlying what has become, in reality, a full-fledged false religion created and exploited by global elites who want to rule the world, let's first consider those segments of society most captivated by this apocalyptic cult.

Strangely, while claiming to follow "the science," global warming cult followers tend to comprise the very population demonstrating the least regard for actual scientific truth in other areas of life and public policy:

This is an entirely accurate, if graphic, representation of the prevailing belief of today's Democratic Party, with 46 Senate Democrats having voted just last year in favor of legalizing abortion up until the very moment of birth.

* This same population segment tends to believe that seriously mentally ill men who claim they are women actually are women – and vice versa. Worse, they defend the practice of grooming thousands of emotionally fragile teenagers into undergoing horrendous amputations and other harmful, irreversible "treatments" in pursuit of gender transitions that are not only scientifically impossible, but insane.

* During the COVID-19 pandemic, despite ever-increasing scientific data regarding the virus and its scandalous origins, unprecedented negative effects of the experimental "vaccines," and the proven safety and effectiveness of lifesaving medications like Hydroxychloroquine and Ivermectin, these are the people who tended to ignore the actual science and instead side with lying, power-addicted federal bureaucrats and greedy pharmaceutical companies.

* What about the news media's obsession with climate apocalypse? Hint: "If it bleeds, it leads." Starting well over a century ago, in 1895, the New York Times scared its readers to death with warnings of a coming "new ice age." This media-driven hysteria lasted into the late 1920s, when the Times suddenly switched gears and warned "the earth is steadily growing warmer." That lasted until 1954, when Fortune magazine led the way with a warning that another ice age was coming. Although the New York Times stoked "global warming" fears into the late 1950s, by 1975 it was back to "new ice age" hysteria. A few years later, the Times reverted back to panicking its readers over global warming of an "almost unprecedented magnitude."

* More troubling, how about all the scientists who have joined the cult of the climate apocalypse? Why would they go along with an overblown, politically driven hoax? The answer, sadly, became clear during the COVID era, when many scientists, doctors and hospitals adopted the questionable views and medical practices of highly politicized and dishonest federal agencies like the FDA and the CDC. Rather than "following the science" themselves – as a few courageous and principled doctors did, and who often were seriously persecuted for their integrity – most doctors and scientists lacked the requisite courage to take a stand and risk losing their positions or even their careers. After all, the saying goes, "I have a family to support."

* Of all the groups swept up into climate hysteria, the easiest to understand would be the millions of young people traumatized and indoctrinated daily in the government ("public") school system about near-term, human-caused catastrophic climate change. Brainwashing a child into fearing

the future and loathing the adults supposedly responsible for destroying their planet is egregious child abuse, as epitomized in the case of Greta Thunberg. Though burdened with autism, OCD and eating disorders, this very troubled 16-year-old Swedish girl somehow was presented to the world as the voice of the younger generation and an expert on climate science, scolding the entire adult population in her famous U.N. speech. "How dare you?" she thundered. "You have stolen my dreams and my childhood." Multiply Greta Thunberg by millions, and one gets a glimpse of what government education and the news media are doing to the next generation.

'Some kind of god'

**SAUDI ARABIA COMMITTED TO PRESERVING ENVIRONMENT, WATER
RESOURCES, MINISTER TELLS WEF**

DUBAI: Saudi Arabia has detailed plans for the protection of its lands and environmental resources, the Minister of Environment, Water and Agriculture said on Sunday.

Speaking at the **WORLD ECONOMIC FORUM IN RIYADH**, Abdulrahman Al-Fadley said: “We have devised our plans based on the preservation of our environment and the management of our water resources. The Kingdom is also providing incentives for the private sector to become more engaged and more responsible toward the environment.”

With 40 percent of lands around the world degraded and further degrading at an alarming rate, critical action is needed as the **UN CONVENTION TO COMBAT DESERTIFICATION** COP16 is set to take place in Riyadh in December.

Al-Fadley said Saudi Arabia had preserved millions of hectares of land and set up programs for cloud seeding and increasing the number of dams in the country.

“This will not only be beneficial to the Kingdom but for the whole region,” he said. “With us hosting COP16 we are hoping to give the meeting the importance it commands. We don’t want matters to go back to the status quo after COP16 ends.”

Tariq Al-Olaimy, a member of the Global Shapers Community Foundation Board at the WEF, commended King Salman for his land restoration efforts.

“WHEN YOU PUT NATURE FIRST, YOU ARE EQUALLY PUTTING PEOPLE FIRST,” he said. “Nature is our greatest collaborator ... There is no successful growth story without successful land restoration and **THIS STARTS INWARDLY, THROUGH OUR RELIGION, COMMUNITY, VALUES AND MORAL CLARITY.”**

Ibrahim Thiaw, secretary of the UNCCD, warned of global repercussions if the world did not pay heed to environmental safekeeping.

“Entire ecosystems are being destroyed through actions and inactions,” he said. “There has been a 29 percent increase in droughts in the past few years and that is affecting 1.8 billion people around the world. For poor nations that is disastrous and carries a large death toll of animals, people and agriculture. We have to be more proactive and not just emergency-ready. We must attempt to avoid emergencies.”

Thiaw said the Panama Canal’s functionality had been reduced by 12 percent, which was causing a problem for supplies.

“Demand is increasing while resources are shrinking,” he said. “As humanity we have been looking at resources as if they are unlimited. We have not been managing them. Companies need to reset their relationship with nature and we need to focus on land restoration to keep going.”

Naoki Ishii, director of the Center for Global Commons, had similar concerns.

“We are on a collision course,” he said. “The only solution is to modify our economic system. COP16 must be transformative for all of us. We need the political momentum to implement positive changes.

“If we are able to push those efforts, economically and ideally speaking, that will be a game changer.”

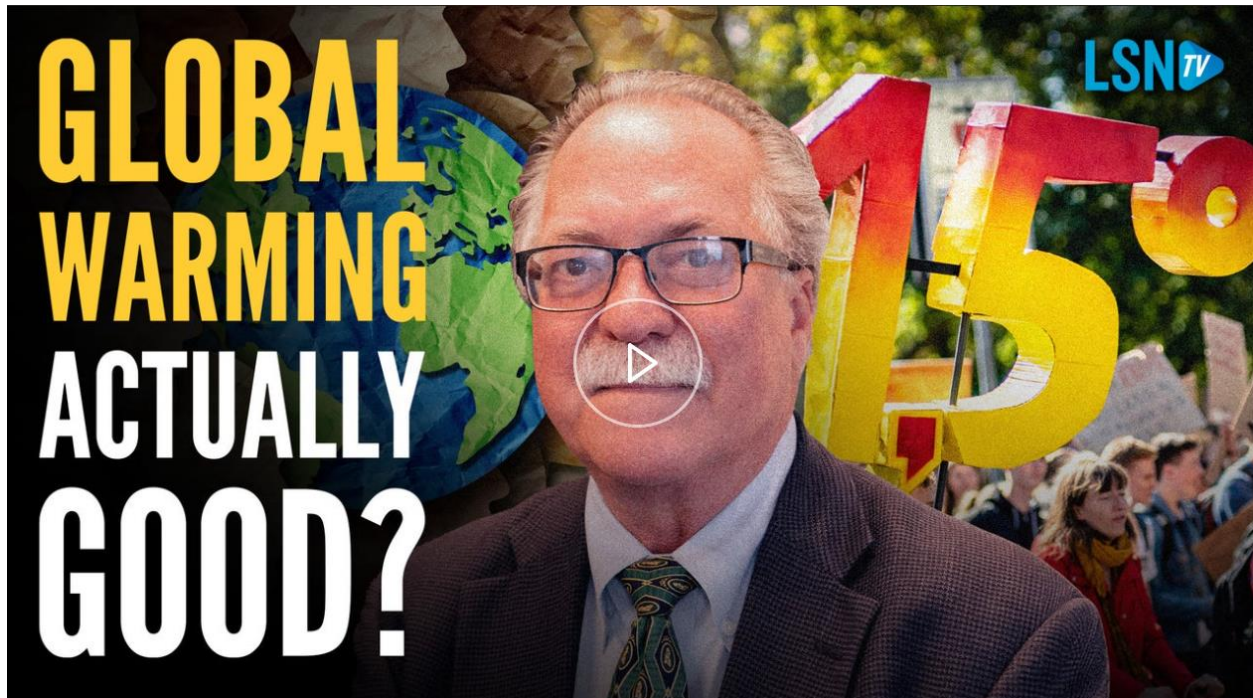
